#### A Note from our Director of Music

"God has bestowed upon His people the gift of song. God dwells within each human person, in the place where music takes its source. Indeed, God, the giver of song, is present whenever His people sing His praises."

I've opened the last three weeks' worth of bulletins with this line, which comes from the opening of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' document, *Sing to the Lord*; it states the importance of using our gift of music, no matter how big or small it may be, to sing God's praises. This weekend I would like to, as I did last week, extend an invitation to any new members who may want to sing God's praises through the choir ministry.

Our choir will resume singing the Sunday Masses beginning on September 23 at the 10AM Mass. I want to take this opportunity to invite anyone high school age or older to join our choir as we begin another season. If you are interested in this ministry, please contact me at 330-770-6504 or see me after any weekend Masses in the weeks ahead.

This weekend, we hear of a few of Jesus' healings in the Gospel. In the second verse of our offertory hymn "Sing of Mary," we recall that this was one of Jesus' missions. To be sent forth from Mary's side to preach, to heal and of course to suffer. We hear of His healing ministry today. But our second reading reminds us that Jesus came to show His mercy towards those who were poor. Our communion hymn, "Blest Are They" reminds us of this: that those who are poor in spirit are the ones who enter the Kingdom of God. God's mercy is endless, as we praise him in our opening hymn, "Praise My Soul the King of Heaven," we sing about His mercy and healing: "ransomed, healed, restored, forgiven." Christ shows us that He has mercy and compassion for those who come to Him. For this we should be ever thankful, as we conclude Mass this weekend in a hymn of thanksgiving, remembering what we hear in the first reading that it is Christ who has come to save us.

#### **From the Rector**

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

#### In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic</u> <u>Church:</u>

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faith-ful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis. 
