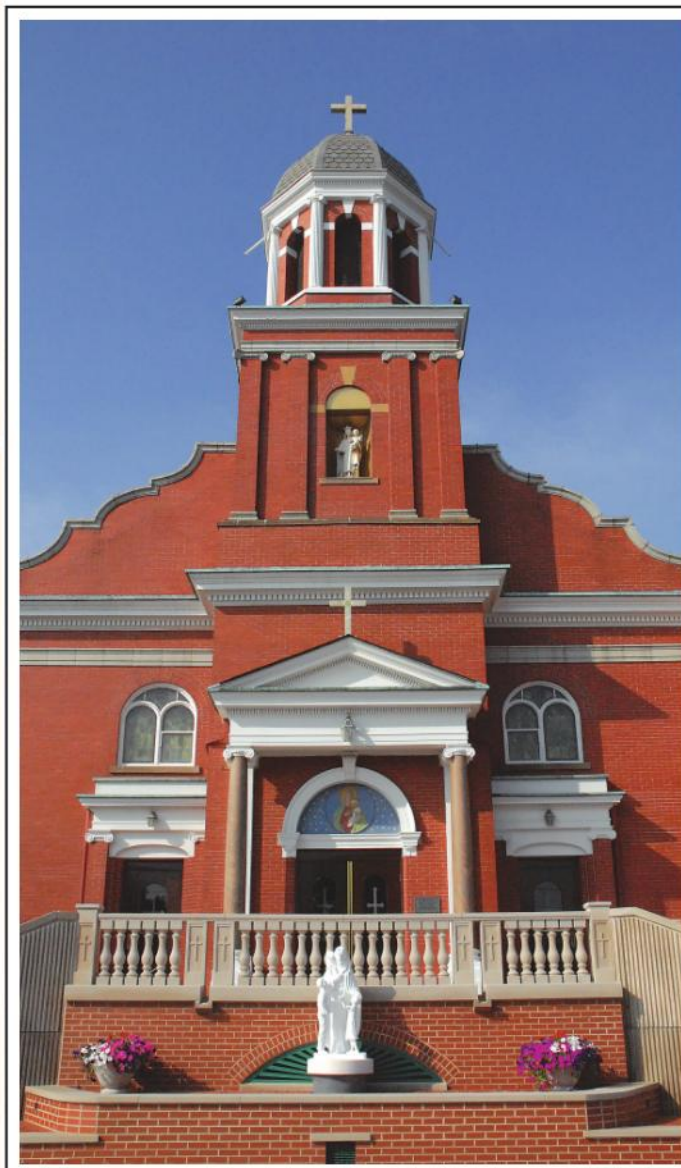

Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend's Scriptures open before us God's creation and all its beauty. Our readings and music this weekend remind us of coming to a wedding Mass, where the Sacrament in the Church promotes further creation of future generations. We recall the Genesis account of creation this weekend, echoed by Christ. We also hear the praise of creation, through the words of Saint Francis of Assisi, split between our opening and closing hymn this weekend, "All Creatures of Our God and King." Many of you brought your pets to the basilica grounds this weekend as we honor Saint Francis' feast day as the patron of animals.

Another hymn of praise of creation is "For the Beauty of the Earth," which we sing at our offertory this weekend. As Monsignor preached about last weekend, God is the source of all good things. Creation itself was good; it was human nature that caused us to need our Savior. Jesus ends the Gospel this weekend by placing an innocent child in the midst of the disciples. Together with His creation, maintaining the innocence of our youth and adhering to His commandments, we build up the kingdom on earth. The letter to the Hebrews we hear in the second reading today reminds us also of our origin in Christ. This is the theme of our communion hymn, "One Bread, One Body." While we all come from different backgrounds and ethnicities, we are all here from one source: Christ. Everything is summed up through our love of God and one another, as our solo communion hymn and choir anthem proclaims.

Let us this weekend, as we sing of God's creation and praise Him for all the good in this world which He bestows upon us, remember our origin in Christ and as our offertory hymn states, raise to Him our songs of praise. Whether brother, sister, parent, child, or like our communion hymn states, "Servant or free, woman or man, we are all one bread and body in our one Lord."

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the **Catechism of the Catholic Church**:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.
