

A Note from our Director of Music

We live in a world where we are constantly bombarded with advertisements for this product or that brand new phone or tablet with all the gadgets you can think of! This weekend, however, we are called to realize what *really* matters in our Christian journey. Our first reading from Wisdom offers us insight into how prudence, careful thought in providing for the future, relates to our spiritual journey. Riches and gold are nothing compared to the true understanding and insight we gain if our spiritual lives are enriched by Christ. Christ echoes this in the Gospel this weekend where He tells a rich man to go sell his possessions in order to find true wealth in Him. Does this mean it's bad to have the newest Samsung Galaxy phone? No, but as the letter to the Hebrews states in the second reading, we need to discern the thoughts of our heart: what we need for our spiritual journey first, *then* what we need for our earthly journey.

The Book of Psalms is a great place to go when we want to focus on Christ and less on the things of this world and gain a deeper understanding of God. Psalm 90 states that before the hills stood, or when earth came into being, God has always been, and God always will be; regardless of our perception of time, a thousand years is like an evening in the eyes of God who sees for eternity. Part of this psalm is paraphrased in our opening hymn this weekend, "O God, Our Help in Ages Past." The hymn tune for this hymn is "St. Anne" and is the subject of the fugue melody in both the prelude and postlude this weekend. *God* is our eternal home, not the newest technology or fad on earth. Christ reaffirms in His statement to the rich man today that if we want to attain that eternal home, we follow Him. Psalm 40, our communion psalm this weekend, states that we are here to do God's will.

This weekend, may the seed of Christ's teaching reach our inner souls that our faith may blossom into action, so that we will give honor to Christ and His name that we bear as Christians. This sentence comes from both verses of our closing hymn, "Sent Forth by God's Blessing." It is our Christian call to live in love of God, neighbor, and self. We are called to do what we need to do on earth to live our earthly lives, but put more time and effort into preparing ourselves for the eternal time scale which God sees. The choir anthem this weekend, "Wisdom's Feast" (which can also be found in our missalettes at #250 if anyone wants to use this text as a prayer before Mass in coming weeks), blends the first reading to our Eucharistic banquet.

Since the month of October is dedicated to the Rosary, let us pray that as we honor our Blessed Mother at offertory this weekend, we take her example of humility with us this week. Let us, like her, focus on her Son and His message as we sing the psalms and hymns this weekend.


