#### A Note from our Director of Music

"Music arises out of silence and returns to silence. God is revealed both in the beauty of song and in the power of silence. The Sacred Liturgy has its rhythm of texts, actions, songs, and silence. Silence in the Liturgy allows the community to reflect on what it has heard and experienced, and to open its heart to the mystery celebrated. Ministers and pastoral musicians should take care that the rites unfold with the proper ebb and flow of sound and silence. The importance of silence in the Liturgy cannot be overemphasized."

This directive, taken from the United States Bishops' document *Sing to the Lord*, states how important silence is in our Liturgies. While music is a vital part of our celebration of Mass, the document also reminds us that silence is also very important. Periods of silence inserted into Mass often take place between the readings and the Gospel Acclamation prior to the Gospel, and before and after communion. As music minister, I always wait a few moments before beginning the communion hymn to allow for silence as well as after the communion hymn either as the ministers are finishing up at the tabernacle, or the presider will return to the chair and sit in silence briefly before the post-communion prayer. Often times also, the presider may say the traditional "let us pray" and wait a few seconds for silent reflection before continuing on with the prayer.

This weekend's Gospel and hymns focus on the healing and consoling power of Christ. It is the faith of the blind man, Bartimaeus which Jesus notices and heals him. So in our lives and in our faith are we healed, restored and forgiven, as our opening hymn states. In the first reading, the Prophet Jerimiah states that it is the Lord who gathers the blind and lame, leading them to brooks of water so that they cannot stumble. Our offertory hymn also reminds us that it is our faith in Christ which should comfort us in our trials. We may not be blind like Bartimaeus, but we do have our needs which we place upon Christ in our faith. Like Bartimaeus, the Gospel, Psalm, and Communion hymns this weekend, remind us that we will see the goodness of the Lord and be filled with joy if we come to him in faith.

Let us take our faith, and through our hymns this weekend, as well as in the periods of silence, use each moment of Mass to pray and praise the Lord, our rock and fortress, who heals us.




