

OSTIA: is again available this Christmas Season in the rectory. There is no need to call ahead, just stop at the rectory between 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to purchase at \$6.00 per box of (50).

HOST:

1 cup lukewarm water

1 cup flour

1 tsp + few drops of oil

Dash of Salt

Beat mixture for 5 minutes. Let stand 5 hours, stirring every half hour. (This recipe is for use with an Ostia maker and if none is available, you may purchase the Ostia at the rectory).

FILLING:

1 Bag of Hershey Kisses or 1 large Hershey Bar 1/2-3/4 lb. skinned almonds

1 pint of honey

OPTIONAL:

Orange extract, grated orange rind or vanilla. Melt chocolate in double boiler or microwave. Add honey at the same time. When all is melted, add chopped almonds and flavoring. Remove from heat and fill host.



A Note from our Director of Music

This weekend, the Solemnity of Jesus Christ as King of the Universe, marks the final week of the Liturgical calendar. The Church Year began late last November with the First Sunday of Advent. Through the seasons we have awaited His coming in Advent, we've celebrated Christmas and Epiphany, we commemorated His Passion, Death and Resurrection and coming of the Spirit at Pentecost, and we have heard many parables and teachings of our Lord. As a basilica parish named in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we take time out of our Liturgical Year also to celebrate the Mother of God in a special way. Everything we have celebrated since last Advent culminates in this great solemnity today.

Our readings and our music lifts up Jesus as King this weekend. We enter the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass acclaiming Jesus as our Sovereign King: victor, ruler, Lord and Redeemer. Our offertory reflects on the name of our King, Jesus, crowning him Lord of All, just as our closing hymn praises Him on the throne of everlasting glory.

As we sang last weekend about the new Jerusalem, this weekend our readings reiterate the kingship of Jesus as not of this world. We hear that He is the Alpha and Omega, robed in majesty, here to testify to the truth. We are called to listen to His

As we culminate this Liturgical Year, and praise our King, our scriptures open before us the future. Not earthly future, but our heavenly future where the Kingship of Christ endures forever.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION **Cold and Flu Season Reminder**

During the cold and flu season please remember the following helpful and healthy reminders while at Mass:

General Considerations:

Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or cough/sneeze into your elbow.

Wash your hands with soap and water frequently. Alcohol based hand cleaners are also effective.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

Sign of Peace:

Do not be offended if someone chooses not to shake your hand at the sign of peace. If you are ill (and present at Mass, the appropriate response to someone extending a sign of peace might be to bow to them and say, "Peace be with you," to avoid contact while sick.

Reception of Holy Communion:

While it is the teaching of the Church that the fullness of the Body and Blood of Christ is contained in the Holy Eucharist under the form of the host that is distributed at Mass, the Church has also extended the privilege to receive Holy Communion under the form of wine. However, if you are feeling ill, please consider receiving Holy Communion in the hand and refrain from receiving the Precious Blood until you are returned to good health.


