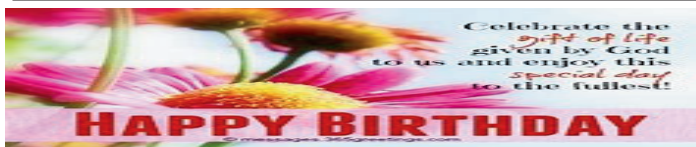
**SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT
