FOR YOUR INFORMATION COLD & FLU SEASON REMINDER

During the cold and flu season please remember the following helpful and healthy reminders while at Mass: General Consideration:

Sign of Peace:

While it is the teaching of the Church that the fullness of the Body and Blood of Christ is contained in the Holy Eucharist under the form of the host that is distributed at Mass, the Church has also extended the privilege to receive Holy Communion under the form of wine. However, if you are feeling ill, please consider receiving Holy Communion in the hand and refrain from receiving the Precious Blood until you are returned to good health.





