From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis.

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



A Note from our Director of Music

When I was studying organ at Youngstown State, I had to take a course in Organ Literature, studying different types of organ music from all traditions, cultures, and time periods. One of the most prominent periods for the development of organ music was in the Baroque Period in Europe from 1600 to 1750. Organ music developed rapidly during this time, especially in Germany and France. One style that stood out to me was that of the French Baroque "noels," which were short melodies with a simple Christmas-themed text. These noëls used a wide variety of sounds on the organ, some of which were new, such as the trumpet. These pieces often are structured by an embellished melody and variations between flute and trumpet sounds with very little bass.

The composer of this weekend's postlude noel is Claude Balbastre (1727-1799) who was a famous French organist and composer at Notre Dame in Paris. He would perform his own variations on the noels he wrote for Notre Dame every Midnight Mass, attracting such a crowd that the Parish archbishop forbade him to play longer because too many people were coming to the cathedral as a concert atmosphere rather than because of respecting the Church. In today's postlude, you'll notice each movement of the noel has the same melody but a different improvisation technique and variation – exactly why Balbastre composed it as such!

The solemnity of the Epiphany which we celebrate this weekend is Jesus' manifestation to the entire world. He was made manifest by the star which the three kings followed which led them to Him. Isaiah foreshadows Jesus as this light in today's first reading; our Psalm today foreshadows the gifts of the kings, which we hear of in the Gospel. This weekend's hymns also tell the Epiphany story.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION Cold and Flu Season Reminder

During the cold and flu season please remember the following helpful and healthy reminders while at Mass:

General Considerations:

Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or cough/sneeze into your elbow.

Wash your hands with soap and water frequently. Alcohol based hand cleaners are also effective.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Sign of Peace:

Do not be offended if someone chooses not to shake your hand at the sign of peace. If you are ill (and present at Mass, the appropriate response to someone extending a sign of peace might be to bow to them and say, "Peace be with you," to avoid contact while sick.

Reception of Holy Communion:

While it is the teaching of the Church that the fullness of the Body and Blood of Christ is contained in the Holy Eucharist under the form of the host that is distributed at Mass, the Church has also extended the privilege to receive Holy Communion under the form of wine. However, if you are feeling ill, please consider receiving Holy Communion in the hand and refrain from receiving the Precious Blood until you are returned to good health.
