Craig's Corner

A Note from our Director of Music

Last Sunday, after the proclamation of the Gospel, the Roman Missal (the red book which contains all of the prayers and directives of our celebration of the Mass) directed the chanting of the Epiphany Proclamation. This was chanted at the Masses before the homily and contained the moveable feasts of the coming calendar year. The full text of the chant is as follows:

"Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior. On the sixth day of March will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. On the twenty-first day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the second day of June will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the ninth day of June, the feast of Pentecost. On the twenty-third day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the first day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory forever and ever. Amen."

This weekend, celebrating the Baptism of the Lord, we conclude the Christmas season and open up the remainder of our Liturgical calendar. The dove appeared in this weekend's Gospel to note that Christ has once again been manifest to the world, this time at His baptism. Last week we celebrated his manifestation by the star to the Magi and next week we will celebrate another manifestation of Christ, in His first miracle at the wedding at Cana.

Our communion psalm this weekend acclaims that we have seen the saving power of God, now made manifest in the Son, Jesus. As we go through the Liturgical calendar of 2019 which continues to open before us, let us travel our weeks ahead with the spirit of Christmas every day.

**FOR YOUR INFORMATION**  
**Cold and Flu Season Reminder**

During the cold and flu season please remember the following helpful and healthy reminders while at Mass:

General Considerations:

Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or cough/sneeze into your elbow.

Wash your hands with soap and water frequently. Alcohol based hand cleaners are also effective.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

Sign of Peace:

Do not be offended if someone chooses not to shake your hand at the sign of peace. If you are ill and present at Mass, the appropriate response to someone extending a sign of peace might be to bow to them and say, "Peace be with you," to avoid contact while sick.

Reception of Holy Communion:

While it is the teaching of the Church that the fullness of the Body and Blood of Christ is contained in the Holy Eucharist under the form of the host that is distributed at Mass, the Church has also extended the privilege to receive Holy Communion under the form of wine. However, if you are feeling ill, please consider receiving Holy Communion in the hand and refrain from receiving the Precious Blood until you are returned to good health.
