

A Note from our Director of Music

In a 1981 document from the Sacred Congregation for the Sacraments and Divine Worship, the second edition of the General Introduction to the Lectionary outlines how the Word of God is to be proclaimed on Sundays and weekdays. It reminds us that,

The best instance of harmony between the Old and New Testament readings occurs when it is one that Scripture itself suggests. This is the case when the doctrine and events recounted in texts of the New Testament bear a more or less explicit relationship to the doctrine and events of the Old Testament. The present Order of Readings selects Old Testament texts mainly because of their correlation with New Testament texts read in the same Mass, and particularly with the Gospel text.

This section of text discusses the relationship between our first reading and Gospel on many of our Sunday readings. This weekend is no different, as the first reading from the prophet Jerimiah warns that the Lord told him that kings and princes will rise against him but not prevail. Jesus in the New Testament Gospel this weekend also faces opposition, even to the point where He states, "no prophet is accepted in his own native place." Jesus' own people in the synagogue are trying to hurl Him out.

A second reading does not always directly function together with the first reading or Gospel but is always taken from one of the New Testament epistles or the book of Revelation. It offers insight into how to apply the theme from the Gospel into life or a general teaching. This weekend's second reading is a familiar one in many weddings because it discusses the role of love. This is the central focus of many of our hymns this weekend as well. Those who tried to oppose Jerimiah and Christ's message lacked love, which Paul tells us never fails. Jesus' ministry, and our Christian call, is about love of God and love of others. Those who do not accept this message are like those who tried to hurl Jesus out of the synagogue. But if we live according to the second reading and our hymns this weekend, we promote a culture of love.

From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church:</u> An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- 2. June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis. 


