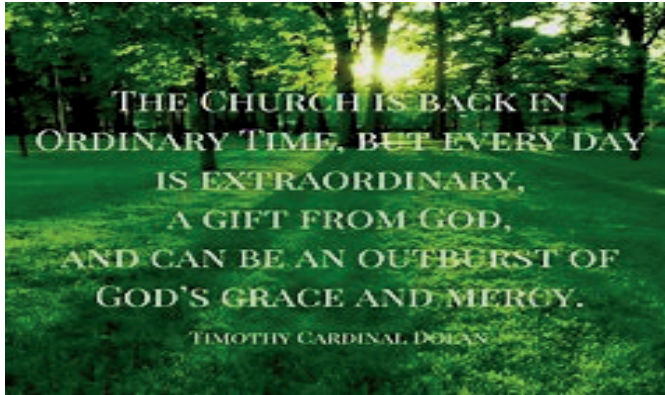

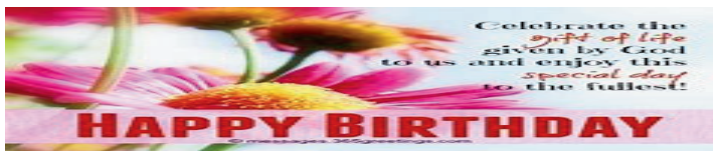
**SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
