ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

St. Thomas Aquinas was born on January 28, 1225 in Roccasecca, Italy near Aquinas Terra di Lavoro in the Kingdom of Sicily. Saint Thomas Aquinas OP was an Italian Dominican Friar Catholic priest, and Doctor of the Church. He was an immensely influential philosopher, theologian, and jurist in the tradition of scholastiscism, within which he is also known as Doctor Angelicus and the Doctor Communis.

The Catholic Church honors Thomas Aquinas as a saint and regards him as the model teacher for those studying for the priesthood & other religious formations.
