

A Note from our Director of Music

One iconic building in our city of Youngstown is the Stambaugh Auditorium located on Fifth Avenue. Home to many events such as graduations, concerts, and weddings, the auditorium is a staple in the Youngstown community. The auditorium houses a magnificent pipe organ, which originally built in the 1920s by the Earnest M. Skinner Company of Boston. The Skinner Company was one of the most prestigious organ builders of the time and it was a no-brainer that the auditorium should be furnished with an instrument of such caliber. Large organs in concert halls and such venues as Stambaugh dates back to Europe's great halls where cities contended with each other on who had the best instruments. Adding the EM Skinner organ to our auditorium allowed the city of Youngstown to be "put on the map" in terms of musical pride in the world of organ music at concert halls.

The organ itself was built specifically for the architecture of the auditorium. It contains around four thousand pipes used to accompany singers, symphony orchestras, or play just about any type of organ repertoire written. Some of the sounds available to the organist are things common to many organs such as trumpets or flute sounds, but some fun sounds include a harp, tuba, French horn, clarinet and many others. Other Skinner organs in the country are located at Cleveland Public Auditorium and Washington National Cathedral.

The organ was out of service for a long period of time after years of neglect and water damage. A large capital campaign was launched to restore the instrument. It was restored in 2010 at a cost of \$1.4 million. Not long after the restoration, a celebratory concert was held to inaugurate the restored instrument in 2011 with the Youngstown Symphony Orchestra.

Today, the auditorium seeks organists to come in and keep the instrument in working order. I was fortunate enough to be one of those organists a few weeks ago where I got about two hours on the instrument and see all it had to offer. From the Rector

Dear Friends in Christ,

From time to time I have been asked how to gain a Plenary Indulgence.

In answer I borrow from the <u>Catechism of the Catholic</u> Church:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of Redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury and satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is plenary as it removes all temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living and the dead.

Pope Francis has granted to Our Lady of Mt Carmel minor Basilica special days for the opportunity of a plenary indulgence by the Faithful:

- 1. May 13th—the day Pope Francis by decree elevated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church to a minor basilica.
- June 29th the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles.
- 3. July 16th Feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.
- 4. October 7th the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- 5. December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day of the dedication of the basilica.
- 6. Once a year on a day freely chosen by each of the Faithful.

The Faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and the prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff Our Holy Father Pope Francis. 
