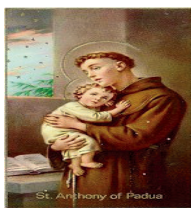

**Fasting and Abstinence**

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

Earlier this month, our offertory anthem was entitled “Dear Lord and Father of Mankind.” Since it’s not a hymn we have in our misallettes, the text is presented here.

Dear Lord and Father of mankind,  
 forgive our foolish ways;

 in deeper reverence, praise.

If we want to follow His call, and continue what we’ve heard in the Gospels these past few weeks, we must follow the law of love. This weekend’s hymns focus on love, with the third verse of our opening hymn “Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee” being the perfect musical connection to the Gospel.

“Loving Father, Christ our brother, All who live in love are thine; teach us how to love each other, Lift us to the joy divine.” In these last weeks, we have been re-introduced to the mission of Christ and that continues this weekend as we hear of his law of love. He is the King of Love, our Shepherd. If we live in this love, we are His as well, and pray that we are able to produce this love and forgiveness He speaks of this weekend, no matter how difficult it may be, so that we can be lifted to the joy divine!

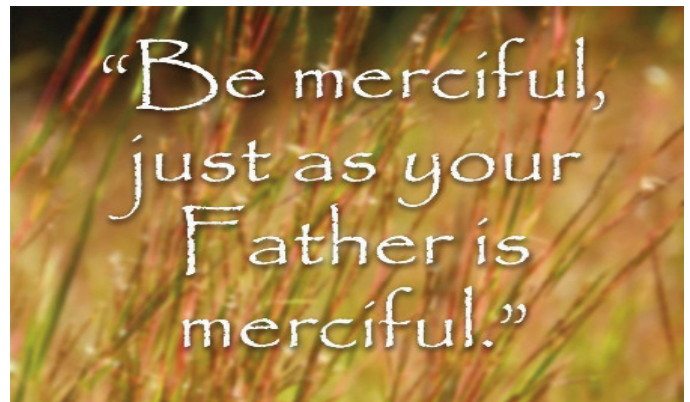

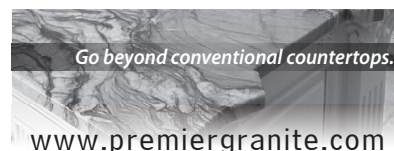
