


Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

In these last weeks, we have been re-introduced to the mission of Christ and that continues this weekend as we hear of his law of love. He is the King of Love, our Shepherd. If we live in this love, we are His as well, and pray that we are able to produce this love and forgiveness He speaks of this weekend, no matter how difficult if may be, so that we can be lifted to the joy divine!






