Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

A Note from our Director of Music

A word that we sing in the refrain of our Italian hymn, Ti Ringrazio, O Mio Signore ("I Give Thanks to You, O My God") is alleluia. This word, which is an exclamation of praise or rejoicing, is heard all during the church year with the exception of one season: Lent. On Wednesday, we begin this penitential season where the word alleluia will be withheld from liturgical celebrations until the Easter Vigil. It leaves a certain void in our celebrations as we seek God's mercy and forgiveness so that our lives are renewed when we are washed away from sin in the waters of new baptism at Easter. Another noticeable change in Mass will be the absence of the Gloria except on solemnities. These joyful things that are taken away during Lent are not supposed to instill sadness but rather a longing for the expectation of Easter and new life. So should the music during Lent should also not instill sadness, but rather a longing and penance within us to be consistent with the tradition of the Church.

But for this weekend, let us sing our alleluias loudly! I placed "All Creatures of Our God and King" with verses split between the opening and closing hymn this weekend so that we can sing that word ever more joyfully and, for offertory, "Alleluia! Sing to Jesus." The Ti Ringrazio with its alleluias also parallels with this weekend's psalm where we sing that it is good to give thanks to the Lord. The verses of the psalm show images of nature, which connects with the All Creatures hymn. This is also the inspiration to this weekend's pastorale (nature song) prelude. The first reading and Gospel also use nature to teach the message of care for one another just like the trees produce either good or bad fruit. We must be the trees which produce good fruit in our care for nature and one another.

So this weekend, we give thanks to God, continue to learn his law of love, and sing alleluia. Then, as we enter Lent this Wednesday, let his grace and forgiveness enter ourselves as we prepare our hearts for Easter.




