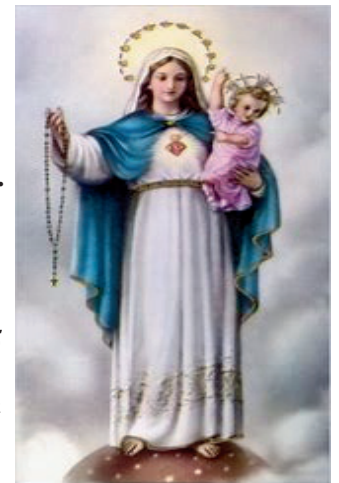

This week we celebrate the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter the apostle. The Lord said to Peter, "You are Peter and upon this rock I will build my Church" Matthew 16:18, and "Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" Matthew 16:19. St. Peter's life is so important to the Church that he has more than one feast day during the year.

This feast day is an anniversary and celebration of the "authority" of the Papacy, and the particular mission entrusted to St. Peter by Jesus. The Roman Missal explains, the symbol of the chair, and emphasizes the mission of teacher and pastor of Christ conferred upon Peter.

Know that God is with you all the time, the Holy Spirit will put the right words in your mouth.
