

SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS: IS JESUS CRAZY?

The expectations and commandments of Jesus—especially to love one's enemies-made people suspicious about him, and his early followers as well. Following Jesus, we should not be surprised if others think we also might be a bit unbalanced!

Jesus offers practical and difficult advice about how to do unto others as God does to us. Those who lived it learned its power: Martin Luther King, Jr., Pope Francis to name a few. They were thought to be crazy. Yet, they show us that love begets love and giving of ourselves opens us to receive God's forgiving love. Earthly logic calls this crazy. Spiritual logic finds sense in this way. So try it. Make good judgements based on this teaching, "Do unto others as God does unto you.

Merciful God, how many times you have forgiven me when I sinned, or taken me back when I turned away from you? Thank you for the many ways in which you love me. Help me learn how to love others the way you love me: unconditionally, compassionately, kindly, and with great mercy. Help me learn how to do unto others as you do unto me each day.

"But rather, love your enemies and do good to them, and lend without expecting anything back."
