LENT

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

A Note from our Director of Music

During the Eucharistic Prayer of Mass, and after the celebrant elevates the host and chalice, he decrees: “let us proclaim the mystery of faith.” At this point, we as a congregation reply with one of three responses. The one we will be singing on Sundays during Lent acclaims, “Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.” During Lent we prepare ourselves to celebrate the saving acts of Christ’s Cross and Resurrection by fasting, prayer, and works of charity. Just as we prepare ourselves for Holy Week and Easter, we hear of how Jesus was tempted by the devil and fasted forty days before he began his ministry in the Gospel this weekend. We hear about the saving acts of God in the story of Moses in the first reading; in the second reading, we are reminded that those who confess Christ are also saved.

In order for us to prepare ourselves to celebrate the saving acts of our salvation, our music at Lenten masses will have a more reserved tone. Our hymns this weekend directly state how we need to open our hearts to this fasting, just as Jesus fasted in the desert. As I stated last week, the music shouldn’t make us sad, but instead should instill a longing and a sense of penance within us. Take the words of the hymns and psalms to heart. Our opening hymn states, “teach us to discipline our wills and follow, Lord, your way,” while our offertory hymn acclaims, “shall not we your sorrow share, and from worldly joys abstain.” There is nothing sad about these texts; rather, they instill in us a deeper prayer to better our lives so that we can be void from worldly things when we celebrate Jesus’ saving acts of our salvation. The postlude music after the conclusion of Mass will also be a stark contrast to what we hear through the rest of the year. This weekend’s postlude is an arrangement of our communion hymn, “Attende Domine” or, “Draw Near, O Lord.”

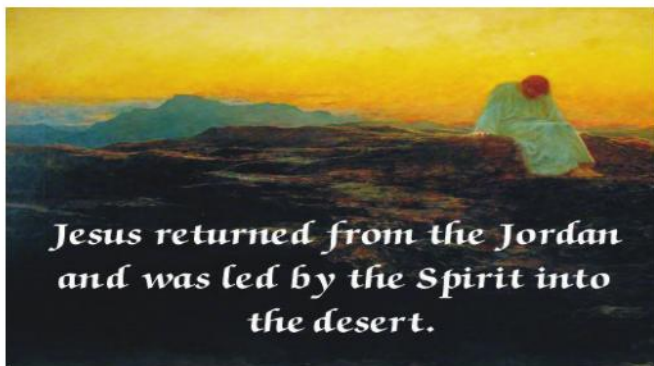
So each weekend when we pray the Memorial Acclamation asking our Savior to save us by His cross and resurrection, and as we sing our Lenten hymns, let us, even more than ever, be attentive to their words and what we are all about during these forty days: increased reverence and prayer. There will be no preludes or organ improvisation following offertory or communion hymns during this season; use these extra silences to bring yourself into deeper prayer as we prepare ourselves to celebrate the great events of our salvation.

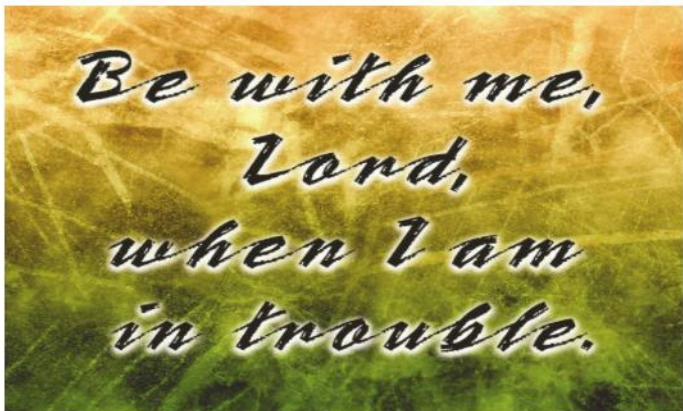

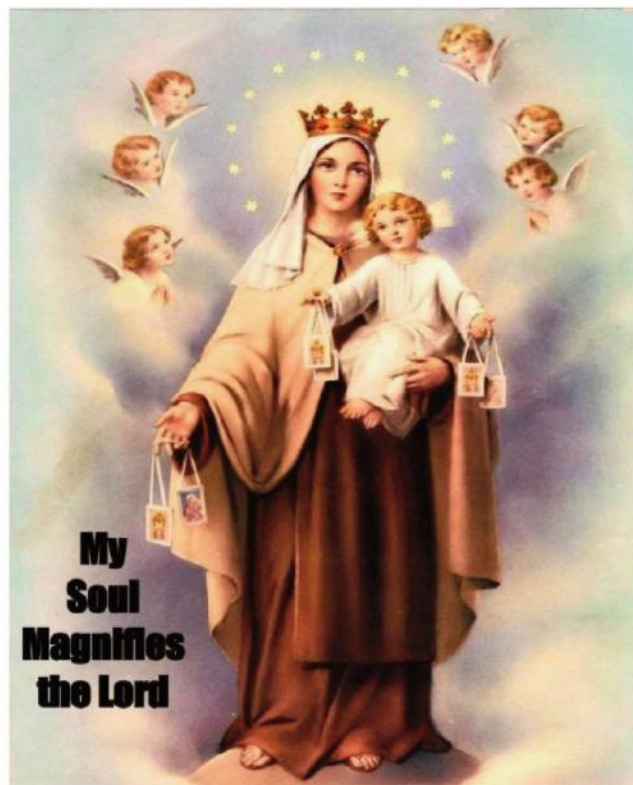
