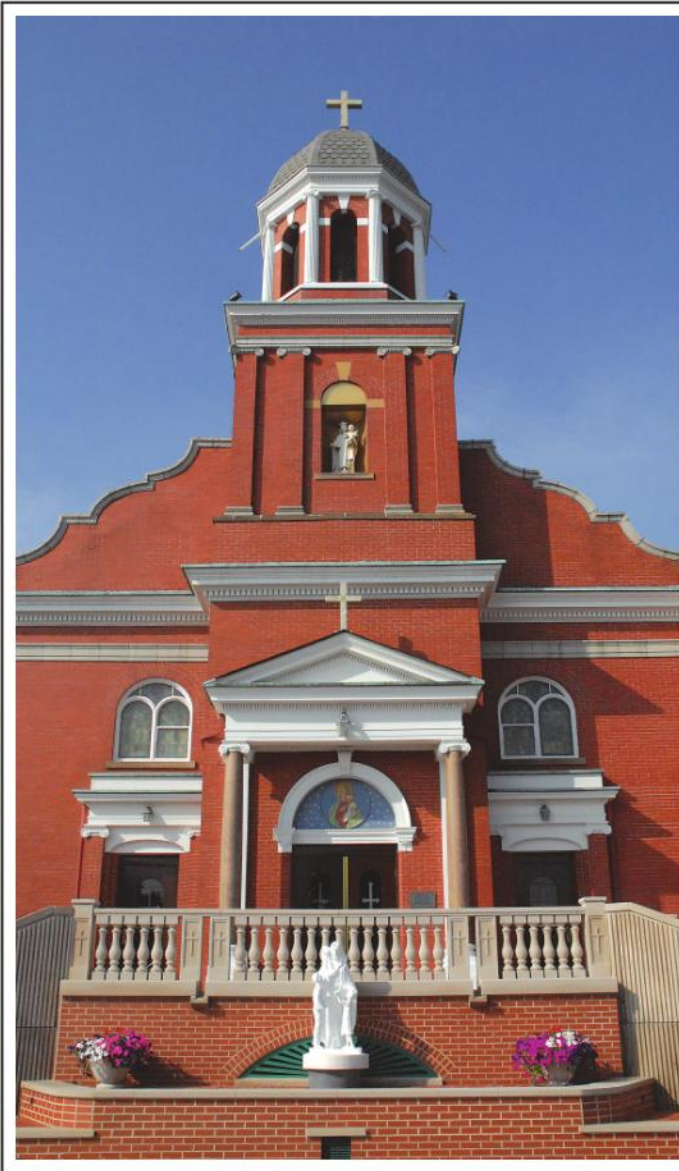

Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting means eating a lesser amount of food. Catholics 18 and not 60 years of age must fast. The days on which we must fast are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of abstinence are days on which we do not eat any meal at all. Dairy products, fish and seafood are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 must abstain. The days of obligatory abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, both the laws of fasting abstinence apply and no meat may be eaten.

Craig's Corner
A Note From Our Music Director

Whether we hear Jesus' words to Martha and Mary at the 10AM scrutiny in the year A readings or Jesus' words to the woman caught in adultery showing us his mercy in the year B readings this weekend, they are meant to remind us of God's love and mercy to us. Jesus tells Martha and Mary that He alone is the Resurrection and Life and that no one can come to the Father except through Him. In the account of the woman in adultery, He forgives her because who are humans to judge? None of us are without sin, and therefore we need God's mercy.

This weekend, our hymns and readings bring us into the portion of our Liturgical calendar known of as *Passiontide*. This is the final two weeks of the Lenten season with our statues now covered, in which we focus on the cross of Christ. On Good Friday, the cross will again be revealed to us and uncovered, allowing us to look upon it in renewed. The cross and resurrection are the actions by which we receive God's grace and mercy to its fullness. Because of the cross and resurrection, we have received forgiveness of sins through Jesus – who is the Resurrection and Life.

The hymn, "We Acclaim the Cross of Jesus" allows us to enter more deeply into the mysteries which we prepare to celebrate as we enter Mass this weekend. Our offertory again allows us time for communal silence as we meditate on what we are about to celebrate – both in the communion we take at Mass, and the coming celebration of the saving acts of the Paschal Mystery. Our communion hymn brings us closer to the cross of Christ as we prepare to walk the final steps with him as we journey to Holy Week. This weekend's Sunday postlude is an arrangement of the ancient Gregorian hymn based on the Year A psalm this weekend, but resonates with the theme of mercy in both sets of readings: "out of the depths, I cry to you, O Lord. Hear my voice in supplication."

Holy water is a sacramental that remits venial sin. Because of the blessing attached to it, Holy Church strongly urges its use upon her children, especially when dangers threaten such as fire, storms, sickness and other calamities. *We do not take advantage of the benefits derived from holy water.* **LET US CULTIVATE ITS USE.**

Untold spiritual wealth is concentrated in a tiny drop of blessed water. *And we give so little thought!* Did we realize now as we shall realize after death, the many benefits which may be derived from holy water, we would use it far more frequently and with greater faith and reverence. Holy water has its great power and efficacy from the prayers of the Church, which its Divine Founder always accepts with complacency. **Following are some of the petitions the priest makes to God when he blesses water.**

O God, the Creator of all things, by water and the Holy Spirit you have given the universe its beauty and fashioned us in your own image. Bless and purify Your Church.

O Christ the Lord from your pierced side you gave us your sacraments as fountains of salvation. Bless and purify Your Church.

O Holy Spirit, giver of life, from the baptismal font of the Church you have formed us into a new creation in the waters of rebirth. Bless and purify Your Church.

PRAYERS EFFECTIVE

These prayers ascend to heaven each time you take holy water and sprinkle a drop either for yourself or for another whether he be present or absent; and God's blessings descend for soul and body.

DISPEL THE DEVIL

The devil hates holy water because of its power over him. He cannot long abide in a place or near a person that is often sprinkled with this blessed water.

DO YOUR DEAR ONES LIVE AT A DISTANCE?

Holy water, sprinkled with faith and piety, can move the Sacred Heart to bless your loved ones and protect them from all harm of soul and body. When worry and fear take possession of your heart, hasten to your holy water font, and give your dear ones the benefit of the Church's prayers.

THE HOLY SOULS LONG FOR IT


Only in Purgatory can one understand how ardently a poor soul longs for holy water. If we desire to make a host of intercessors for ourselves, let us try to realize now some of their yearnings and never forget them at the holy water font. The holy souls nearest to heaven may need the sprinkling of only one drop to relieve their pining souls.

REMITTS VENIAL SINS

Because holy water is one of the Church's sacramentals, it remits venial sin. Keep your soul beautifully pure in God's sight by making the Sign of the Cross carefully while saying, "By this holy water and by the Precious Blood wash away all my sins O Lord."
