





#### PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD



Do you wonder if Barabbas ever truly realized how significant he was? He was the first person to be freed by Jesus' sacrifice. Jesus took his place on the cross, and thus was able to finish His mission to save not just Barabbas, but us as well. St. Paul says "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23). Because of our sins, we die to earth. But because Jesus took Barabbas' place and in turn, our place, on the cross, we have the gift of eternal life.

I remember when the movie, *The Passion of the Christ* came out back in 2004, I was 14 years old. Seeing just how graphic the movie was, many people were skeptical to bring young adults or kids to see this because it was "scary" or "gory." Sometimes it takes something **big** to alter our way of thinking. After all, we celebrate Holy Week every year, so what makes it different than just "any other Palm Sunday?" It can be something as graphic as watching *The Passion of the Christ*, but, as I have alluded to before, sometimes music with or without text can evoke emotion in us that words cannot.

Palm Sunday's texts and music offer two contradictory emotions. We begin Mass in joy with a trumpet fanfare welcoming Jesus into Jerusalem with palm branches. Then, in the blink of an eye, the tone changes. We hear the account of the Suffering Servant in Isaiah's prophecy, and the account of Jesus' passion and death. The communion hymn and postlude dwell on this aspect of our faith. The Saturday postlude, *Passion*, from Reger's 7 pieces for organ is based upon the chorale "Ah Holy Jesus." In verse 2, "Twas I, Lord Jesus, I it was denied thee; I crucified thee" states that by our sins, we allowed for Jesus to be crucified. The final verse states, "Therefore, kind Jesus, since I cannot pay thee, I do adore thee, and will ever pray thee." How can we repay Jesus for his love? In response, we can reflect upon Jesus's sacrifice for our sins. By adoration and penance we can repay Jesus for his sacrifice. The piece begins by introducing the theme on the string stops of the organ. It slowly builds using the crescendo pedal of the organ, which is specifically used in this style, eventually returning to the original tone. The piece concludes by resolving to a major chord, on the softest stop of the organ.

The Sunday postlude, Flor Peeter's Elegie is a piece of mourning by definition. It denotes the final hours of the soul. It clearly states a theme of sadness which only builds through the piece under a sustained pedal bass note denoting the human heartbeat. The climax of the piece denotes the agony of suffering before it dwindles down to the original tone. Then, the bass "heartbeat" rhythm ends as the soul enters eternity, while the chant "In Paradisum" ("May the Angels Lead you into Paradise") - the final chant in the funeral Mass, is clearly stated before the organ accompaniment fades away. I pray that the music this Palm Sunday and Holy Week ahead allows you to come to deeper prayer than ever and that we do not just "go through the motions" this week, but realize what it is we celebrate: we have been saved because Jesus took Barabbas' place. 
