

A Note From Our Music Director

While we know the Easter Season lasts fifty days, it is often overlooked that the Easter Day celebration in the Church lasts for eight days; this is known of as the octave of Easter. The Sunday within this octave, the second Sunday of Easter, was proclaimed to be Divine Mercy Sunday by Pope John Paul II in 2000. The chaplet of Divine Mercy, which begins on Good Friday, draws attention to how through the saving acts of Jesus' death and resurrection, God showed His mercy for His people. Our previous music director at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Mark Izzo, wrote the Canticle of Divine Mercy from the text of the chaplet, which is being used during the offertory procession this weekend.

To show cohesion between this and last Sunday, the prelude at this Sunday's Masses bring back many melodies from Easter weekend. The prelude, with the melody of the chorale "Christ Lag in Todesbanden" is also part of the text of the Easter Sunday sequence, Victimae Paschali Laudes – Christians Praise the Paschal Victim. The psalm used for this weekend is Psalm 118, also heard on Easter Sunday. We hear the text, "The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone. By the Lord has this been done; it is wonderful in our eyes. This is the day the LORD has made; let us be glad and rejoice in it," as a verse with just a different refrain – but all still taken from the same psalm: the psalm of rejoicing.

Of course our hymns this weekend continue the theme of resurrection and Christ's defeat over death: He is the Lamb who was slain who now lives forever, whom we crown in majesty. Let our alleluias and holy anthems rise with the risen Lord! May the full joy of Easter continue in all of us, not just for the Sunday of Easter and this octave, but the remainder of these entire fifty days. The Sunday postlude is one of my favorites, written for the bright trumpets of the organ for a king. It is very fitting to play after our closing hymn, "Crown Him with Many Crowns" which we sing to our risen King!




