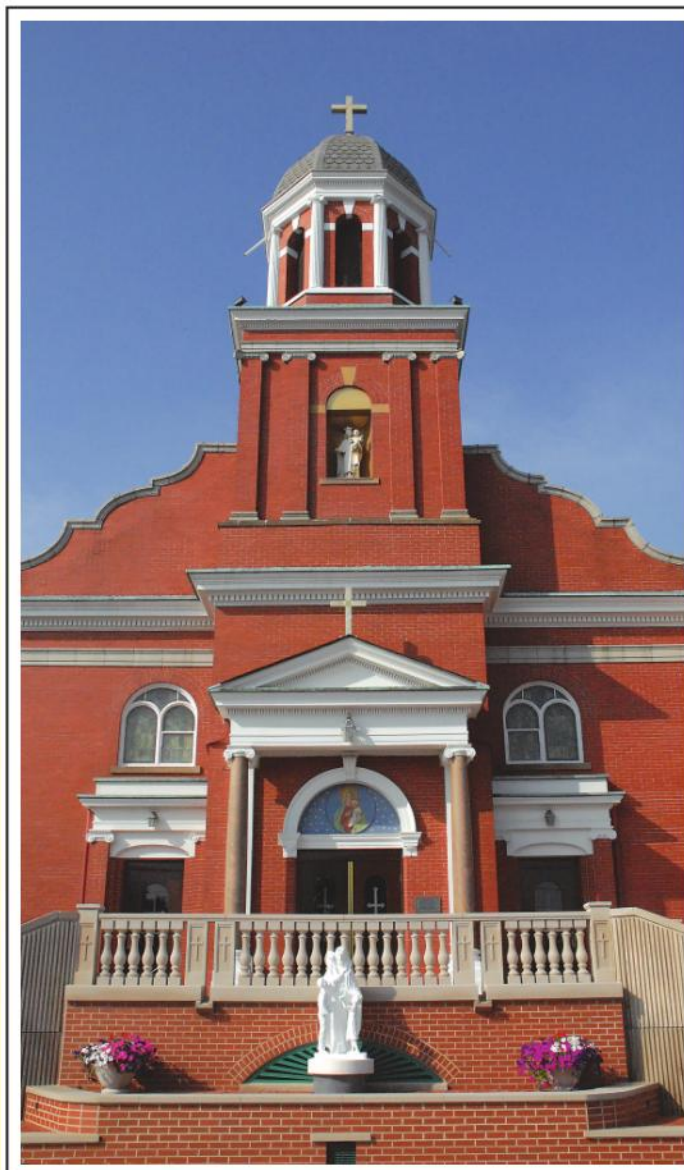

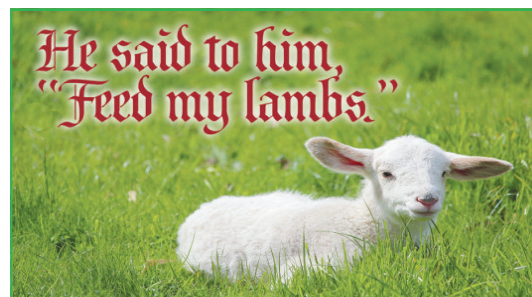

Craig's Corner
A Note From Our Music Director

This weekend we hear of another revelation of Christ following His resurrection. This time, He reveals Himself the way He reveals Himself to us every time we come to Mass – through the breaking of the bread. Our Easter hymns continue this weekend as we continue to celebrate these Easter revelations of Christ.

A hymn we will begin singing in honor of Mary as we go further into the month of May is the beloved hymn “Be Joyful, Mary, Heavenly Queen.” The source of the text of this hymn comes from the Gregorian Chant “Regina Caeli, laetare” (O Queen of Heaven, be Joyful). Our basilica choir sings a classic version of this chant each Easter and you’ll hear it again this month. The Orthodox Church also uses a similar text for the song of Mary, “O Angelos Evoa” (The angel cried to her who was filled with grace, exclaiming: “Rejoice, O purest Virgin”). This weekend’s Sunday Mass prelude is an arrangement of this melody.

The Sunday postlude, Jean Langlais’ “Incantation pour un jour saint” brings back melodies heard when we opened up the Easter season at the Easter Vigil Mass. The piece begins with a direct statement of the “Lumen Christi, Deo Gratias” (“Light of Christ, Thanks be to God”) which began the Easter Vigil Liturgy. The piece continues with quoting the Litany of the Saints, which was sung during the Easter Vigil as the Church welcomed in its newest members in baptism.

As we continue to progress through the fifty days of Easter, we will see images of Christ as the Shepherd, and we will begin preparing our hearts for His ascension and for the coming of the Spirit on Pentecost. As we hear this weekend of Christ’s revelations to the apostles after His resurrection, let us continue to sing our alleluias as we praise the Risen King and as our closing hymn this weekend proclaims, crown him with many crowns as He is now in glorious majesty!
