

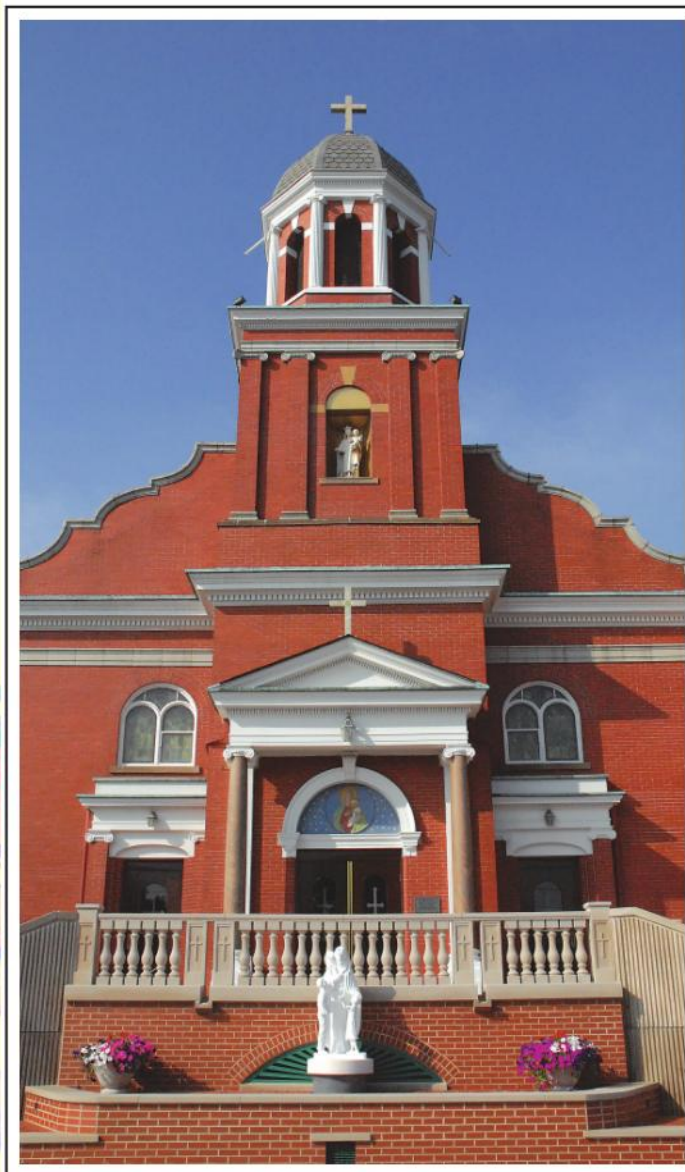

Craig's Corner
A Note From Our Music Director

This weekend we celebrate the image of Christ as our Shepherd. The most common psalm I do at funerals is Psalm 23, "The Lord is my Shepherd." It speaks of comfort as we hear Jesus tell us in the gospel this weekend that He has come to lay down His life and take it up again so that we can rest beside his peaceful waters when our earthly pilgrimage ends. When I accompany the psalm on the organ I often keep the sound as a calm and peaceful accompaniment until verse 4 where it becomes brighter. At this point, the text turns to the heavenly kingdom: "And I shall dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life." This brighter tone echoes an Easter theme of darkness to light, of death to resurrection, to our heavenly goal. A paraphrase of this psalm is the text of the offertory hymn (or at First Communion Mass, during communion itself) this weekend: "The King of Love." Brendan chose this as the tune for the prelude improvisation on Saturday evening.

Pastorale music in the Classical genre paints pictures of the countryside and are common for many religious services across Europe when images of nature appear in Scripture. This weekend for the Sunday Masses, I chose a pastorale for my prelude to open up the theme of Christ as the Shepherd on this Good Shepherd Sunday.

Of course, we also celebrate Mother's Day this weekend as a country, so our closing hymn goes with our May crowning of the Blessed Mother as we sing to her. Our opening hymn at the Masses other than First Communion at 10AM, goes back to what I wrote about last week with the image of Mary rejoicing at the resurrection of her Son: Be Joyful, Mary.

Now that we have celebrated His passion, death and in the past three Sundays have heard three accounts of Jesus' resurrection and appearances to the disciples, we continue the Easter season as we will begin to prepare for Jesus' commission to us to continue His message after His ascension, filled with the Holy Spirit which we will celebrate on Pentecost. Let the words of our hymns and prayers this weekend refresh us, as if by God's restful waters; we should not worry about the valley of darkness, for our Shepherd is with us.

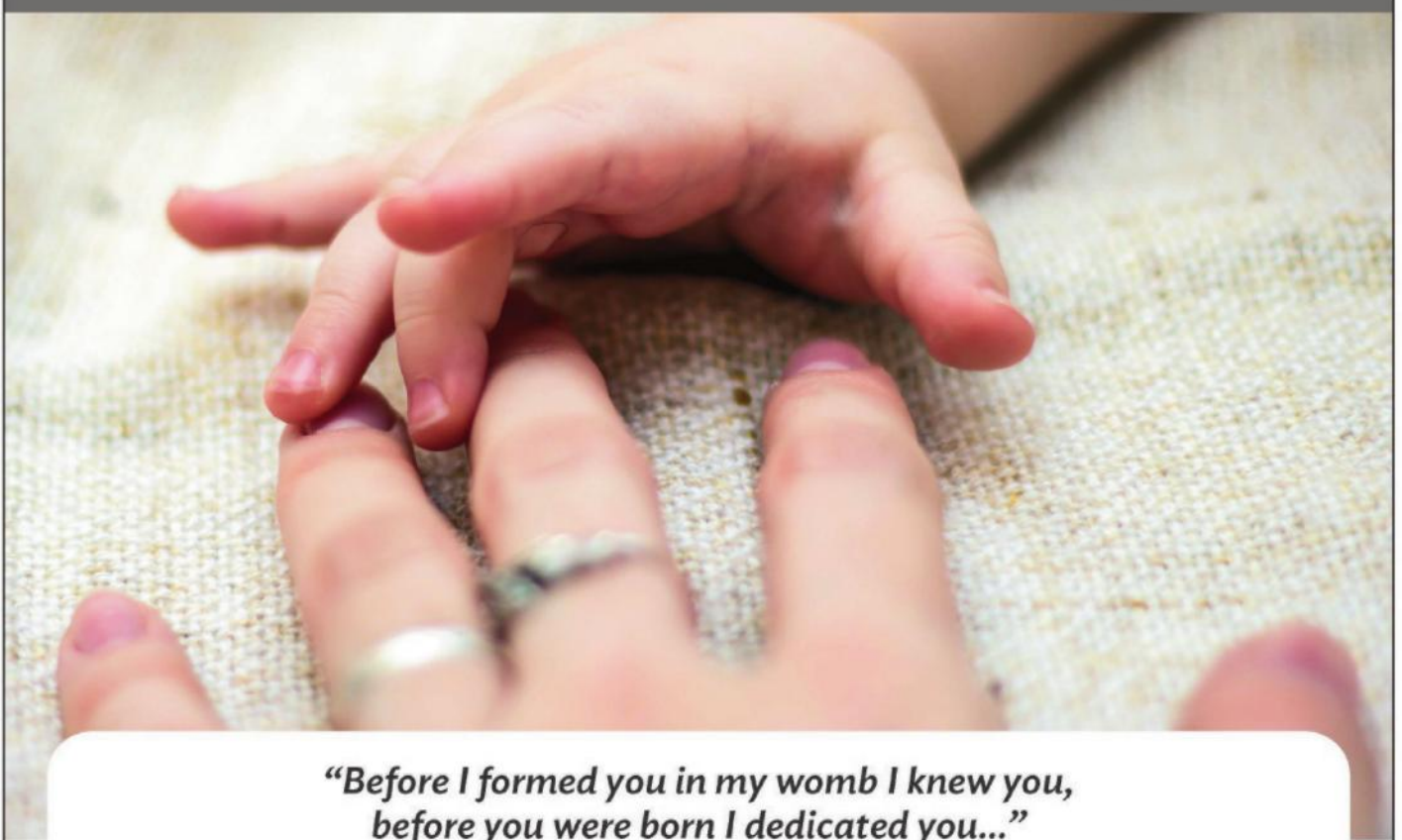
