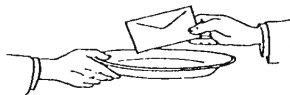

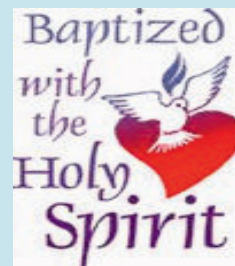

Craig's Corner
A Note From Our Music Director

Our Easter season continues to unfold this weekend before us, but the tone of the season begins to shift at this point in our fifty days of celebration. We have heard several accounts of the revelations of Christ after the Resurrection, and last week He was revealed as the Shepherd watching over us. Now our season shifts towards the final days of Jesus' time on this earth as he prepares the disciples for their role in spreading His message and beginning His Church after He ascends into heaven. This weekend, the Gospel centers on Christ reaffirming His law of love. This weekend's Gospel begins where the Gospel of Holy Thursday left off after Jesus' washing of the feet. These readings come back at this point in the Liturgical Year because as we prepare for the Ascension, we must put ourselves in the position of the apostles.

What we celebrate each year has already historically happened. We don't recreate the events of Holy Week and Easter each year. We commemorate them and let them transform us in our lives of faith. Music in worship must do this as well or else we are just going through the motions. Music connects our Mass and its theme to allow for communal participation. When we listen to the readings and the homily, we also actively participate. But music allows us to verbally participate in addition to our responses to the prayers and readings that are said before us.

In addition to the Gospel, as we hear every Sunday of the Easter season, our first reading continues through the Acts of the Apostles account of the beginning of the Church as it spread. This weekend's music not only keeps our theme of Easter and continues honoring Mary in the month of May, but also reminds us of Jesus' message of love. This message was spoken to the apostles over two thousand years ago, but still has purpose today as we listen to these words as if they are spoken to us. Even in 2019, Christ is still our shepherd as we saw last week. This is the same Christ who asks us to love one another, who promises us the Spirit at Pentecost after the Ascension. This is the Christ who we sing as the risen Lord yet again this weekend, and sing about his law of love he continues to bestow upon us in the Scripture this weekend.
