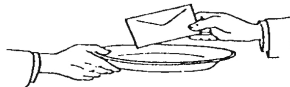

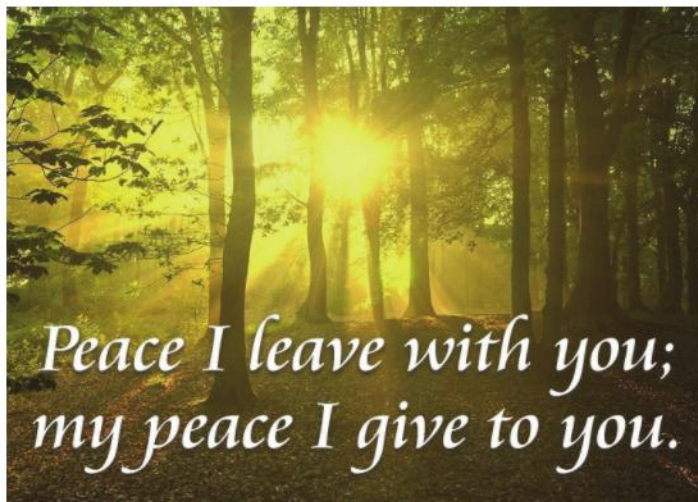

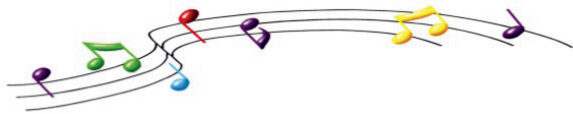
Church at Home Combined Collection, June 2, 2019

**Craig's Corner
A Note From Our Music Director**

If you ask most people what their favorite part of the Liturgical Year is, answers are most likely Advent, Christmas, Holy Week or Easter Sunday – the bigger celebrations. While these are wonderful times of the year in which we can deepen our spirituality, if I was asked this question I would by far pick last week, today and the next couple weeks: the fifth and sixth Sundays of Easter, Ascension and Pentecost. This is the time of the year where the Gospels focus on Jesus' final conversations with his apostles, His commission to the apostles and in turn, our commission to take the teachings and messages we hear all throughout the year and put them into action in our own lives. As always, the music of Mass can reflect this theme as this weekend and the coming weeks, hymns like "We Have Been Told" and "Alleluia! Sing to Jesus" surround these texts where Jesus tells us that he is with us forevermore, to not be afraid, for he is going to prepare a place for us.

I love this time of year because now the focus is not only on the Scripture, but in an even bigger way, the focus is on us. We are now the Church of Christ. We are the ones who are called to spread the message just like the first disciples after the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ. Now it's our turn to take all we have been told, now that we have seen His face through the Scripture accounts – now we go forth to proclaim His name. We do that in word and song each week of Mass and that takes even higher precedence this time of the Liturgical calendar.

On a side note, I wanted to give an update on my other job as meteorologist in the valley. As you all know, I have spent most of my Saturday and Sunday evenings the past few months as the weekend meteorologist on WYTV 33. On May 12, I had my final newscast as a regular on the weekends. I have now moved onto a permanent part-time role between WYTV and WKBN as a fill-in for the full time staff. Last weekend, I filled in on 27 WKBN on the weekend newscasts and this coming week I will be filling in for Jim Loboy on the 33 WYTV Daybreak morning show. I will randomly be filling in from this point forward, so I will be more regularly at 5PM Mass once again. I do want to thank Mark Izzo, Dan Laginya, Christine Langer, and Brendan Kuzior who have helped me so much filling in as organists and cantors through my regular period on Saturday evenings at the TV stations.
