

#### Craig's Corner A Note From Our Music Director

Often times it is difficult to grasp new concepts or hear new ideas. The same holds true in music; new music can often take time to understand and appreciate. Many twentieth century composers used new musical concepts and imagery to write various works. Olivier Messiaen, a Catholic composer from this time period, falls in this category with his "symphonic meditations" titled L'Ascension (Ascension Day) written in 1932-33 for orchestra, but also for organ. Two of the movements are part of our Masses this weekend for prelude and postlude. Since the pieces do not convey traditional musical structure, but that of vivid imagery and deep theology, let our hearts open to this "new" musical language for church so as to understand its symbolic and spiritual depth. The prelude, Prayer of Christ Ascending towards His Father, is inspired by the text: "And now, O Father, I have manifested Thy name unto men...and now, I am no more in the world, but these are in the world and I come to Thee." The piece, which is the conclusion of the entire work, was composed to eternal; with no real end or beginning, but rather simply ascending. It reaches its highest point at its conclusion, then in a sense, vanishes from sight. It ends without resolution, much like the ascension of the Lord. Jesus has left us on this earth, ascending to the Father, while we are commissioned to promote his teachings and way of

The postlude, *Majesty of Christ*, is inspired from the same chapter of John's Gospel as the prelude. The postlude's text, "Father, the hour is come: glorify Thy Son, that Thy Son also may glorify Thee," also creates an eternal tone, where the music doesn't have a destination. Instead the piece alternates between melodic ideas, often times ending in a bright E-Major chord, a chord analyzed by musicologists as the brightest and most triumphant chord in music. The only real motion felt in the movement comes in the final minute as the melodic idea from the rest of the piece is elongated as it ascends, reaching the final E Major chord with every sound of the organ turned on to conclude the piece: ending in bright victory and glory!

I know most of you will read this after hearing these pieces this weekend, but I write this so that we see there is a "method to my *madness*." These type of pieces can truly broaden ones theological and musical mind. The music we hear at Mass doesn't always have to entertain us, but rather it should allow us to transcend to the heavens, hopefully giving us a greater appreciation of our faith. It is my hope that through pieces similar to these in the future, we can use music to bring us to a place words cannot – to allow us to ascend to heavenly thoughts as we celebrate Jesus' ascent to the Father, to prepare for us the place we hope to attain after we depart this world.


