



CRAIG'S CORNER

A Note From Our Music Director

"When one door closes, another one opens." We hear this all the time when something bad happens to us or when we think of some type of ending to a part of our life. In last week's conclusion of Luke's Gospel we heard Jesus tell the disciples right before He ascended, for them to wait for the promise of the Spirit. This was the same concept. As the door of Jesus' time on earth was closing, the door of the Spirit was opening – and that's what we celebrate this weekend: the promised Spirit has come and is now empowering the disciples to go and spread the message.

Today's celebration of the birthday of the Church adds a special element in the Mass (with the exception of the Vigil Mass on Saturday) which is only required twice in the year: the sequence. There are other days where it is optional but only on Easter and Pentecost is it required. The sequence can be done as a congregation, as a choir and congregation piece, or as a cantor or choir alone piece. This year, the Taize *Veni Sancte Spiritus* ("Come, Holy Spirit"), the Pentecost sequence text, is sung as a cantor / choir piece.

The Veni, Sancte Spiritus is different from the Veni, Creator Spiritus ("Come, Creator Spirit), which is another Gregorian chant melody. This chant has become paraphrased into the hymn we know well: this weekend's opening hymn, "Come, Holy Ghost." One way chant melodies were sung in Church history was that of the Chant Mass versets. This was a common practice in the French Baroque period of the 1600-1700s. One verse would be sung by the choir, followed by an organ verse with not necessarily the same melody (although the melody is hidden in the first organ verse) typically highlighting the different sounds of the instrument. Some of the verses for the Veni, Creator chant are split as the prelude and postlude this weekend.

With this feast we celebrate the end of our fifty days of Easter. It is my hope that the music and our celebrations of Lent, the Triduum, and Easter have brought you to a deeper faith in Christ. While Easter ends, our mission only begins. This is the same mission that the disciples proclaimed after receiving power from the Holy Spirit – the Spirit we celebrate today.

The congregational hymns this weekend of course also center on our mission and the descent of the Holy Spirit. Let me conclude with the third verse of our closing hymn. The verse prays, "to us your varied gifts make known, teach us to speak, teach us to hear." All we have celebrated since the coming of Christ on Christmas is culminated this weekend as the gifts of the Holy Spirit come upon us. As our Liturgical Year continues on, we will praise the Trinity and celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ then enjoy the rest of Ordinary Time, hearing the teachings of Christ and of His miracles. As we go forward, let us sing our praise to God, as we carry on His mission renewed by the gifts of the Holy Spirit.


