


CRAIG'S CORNER A Note From Our Music Director

This Sunday's Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ parallels our celebration of Holy Thursday, but since Holy Week is often overshadowed by the Passion of the Lord, early Church leaders wanted another day to also celebrate the Lord's institution of the Eucharist to call extra attention to the mystery at the altar which we celebrate each Mass. After the noon Mass this weekend, we mirror the transfer of the Holy Eucharist on Holy Thursday with our procession of the Eucharist with benediction.

While many composers of our day today continue to write hymns and pieces for our celebration of the sacraments, we cannot lose the texts of the ancient Church which got us to this point in the rich history of our faith. At the offertory this weekend, at our 5PM and 10AM Masses, a beautiful blend of modern music with a historical text is offered through Eriks Ešenvalds' choral work, *O Salutaris Hostia*. The text comes from the final two stanzas of a larger hymn written specifically for Corpus Christi Sunday by Saint Thomas Aquinas back in the 13th Century, while the music for this arrangement was written only a few years ago, in 2015. The text is associated with the ritual of benediction, as it states: *O saving Victim, opening wide*.

O saving Victim, opening wide, The gate of heaven to man below! Our foes press on from every side; Thine aid supply, thy strength bestow. To Thy great name by endless praise, Immortal Godhead, one in Three; Oh, grant us endless length of days, In our true native land with Thee. Amen Wa will sing the more well known tradition

We will sing the more well-known, traditional version of this at the conclusion of our Noon Mass and procession. Jesus, by the institution of the Holy Eucharist before His passion, was set to open the gates of heaven to us below. Parts of our other music this weekend also mirrors the Holy Thursday celebration. The hymn At That First Eucharist, which celebrates the institution of the Eucharist is the subject for the weekend's prelude. This prelude also echoes hints of the melody Adoro te Devote (Humbly We Adore Thee), also referencing the institution of the Eucharist. Our entrance hymn references the Gospel of the multiplication of the loaves (an analogy on the Eucharist), and the communion hymn Let All Mortal Flesh Keep Silence is a beloved text centering around Christ's coming to earth for our salvation and instituting the Eucharist. While we always take time to meditate on the importance of the Eucharist when we celebrate it each Mass, hopefully the joyous setting placed before us this weekend, where we are not overshadowed by Holy Week, we can especially focus on a central aspect of our faith.


