



CRAIG'S CORNER

A Note

From Our Music Director

Our Gospel scene this weekend opens up for us a banquet. Jesus is with Martha and Mary. While Martha is doing all the hard work and serving, Mary is sitting next to Jesus and listening to His words. In the Genesis account in the first reading, Abraham and Sarah are making rolls and attending to strangers, which turns out to be the Lord. These accounts show different methods of service. Our theme of love in recent weeks culminates in manifestation of love through serving the Lord and our neighbors. Even though Martha is doing the serving at the banquet in the Gospel, Jesus tells them that being worried and anxious about many worldly things is not necessary – rather calls attention to Mary, serving the Lord, which brings about true happiness.

These accounts are summed up in the text of the first verse of the hymn "Make Us True Servants" which I played this weekend as an instrumental offertory. Since the hymn is not being sung, the text which sums up our readings is:

Make us true servants to all those in need, Filled with compassion in though, word, and deed; Loving our neighbor whatever the cost, Feeding the hungry and finding the lost.

Our setting at Mass, just as the Gospel this weekend, is a banquet. We come to the banquet of the altar to receive Jesus' body and blood. At the offertory each weekend, we bring forward our gifts to the altar. This is often done by members of the parish. We have a laudable practice at the basilica of bringing baskets for the poor or local organizations during the offertory procession at one of the weekend Masses which remains under the altar for the rest of the weekend. This is another form of service. These are combined in the offertory to show how we serve both God and neighbor. The text of the second verse of our opening hymn "Praise to the Lord" calls our attention to this action of offering our gifts at the altar. This hymn is also the subject of this weekend's postlude.

Let the music and readings of this weekend's Mass call our attention to the need to serve God and one another. As we prepare to celebrate our festival days this upcoming week and weekend, let us appreciate those we have around us and continue to serve one another while serving Christ and His Church.
