



A Note From Our Music Director

The choice of the music this weekend is twofold, both to echo these sentiments from the Scriptures presented to us and to greet our parishioners and guests in celebration as many of us attend our parish festival. We gather praising Jesus our King whose reign is everlasting. He shows us His power and forgiveness daily. He teaches us how to pray this weekend in the Gospel, asking us to seek Him for all of our needs; as the psalm states for on the day we called for help, He answered us. He might not answer our prayers the way we want Him to, but it is His reign as king we celebrate each time we come to the altar. God reminds us in the first reading through the conversation with Abraham of his mercy. Abraham keeps persisting that God save Sodom and Gomorrah, even if just a few innocent people are present. God promises that He will save it if there are even a small number of innocent. We see the persistence of Abraham in the first reading and Jesus teaching His apostles about persistence in prayer in the Gospel. Our communion hymn, "Taste and See" comes from psalm 34. Let us remember this each time we pray in the words Jesus taught us word-forword in today's Gospel which we know of full well as the Our Father.

Since our parish is dedicated to the Blessed Mother, our second communion hymn used at our festival Masses, praises her in a special way sung in our Italian heritage. She is the mother who bore Jesus, whom we pray to with persistence.

While we celebrate with friends and family this weekend on our parish grounds, may we never forget the true reason we are a community: that we are all here because of our faith in Christ Jesus. 


