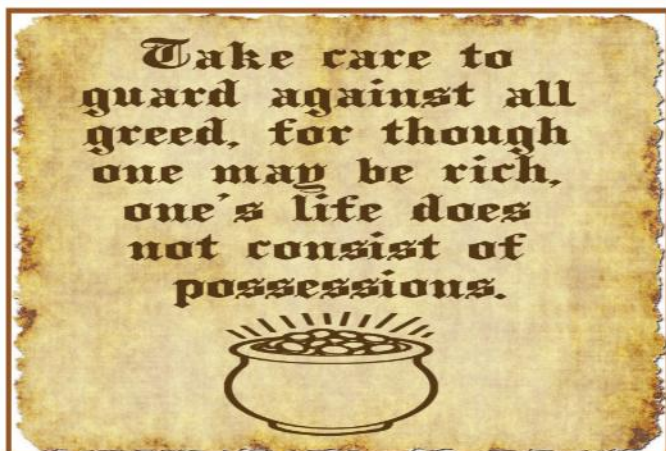

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica,  
I want to take this opportunity to thank the congregation of our wonderful parish community for their participation at Mass each and every weekend. Hearing the voices of so many participants at Mass singing our hymns, psalms, and antiphons brings me great joy and adds so much to my ministry as your director of sacred music. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul states, "Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for the temple of God, which you are, is holy." For your information St. Anthony Church, Youngstown which is also part of the parish will be reducing Masses from two to one Mass every Sunday at 10 am.
