



Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica,

I want to take this opportunity to thank the congregation of our wonderful parish community for their participation at Mass each and every weekend. Hearing the voices of so many participants at Mass singing our hymns, psalms, and antiphons brings me great joy and adds so much to my ministry as your director of sacred music. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul states, "Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 
