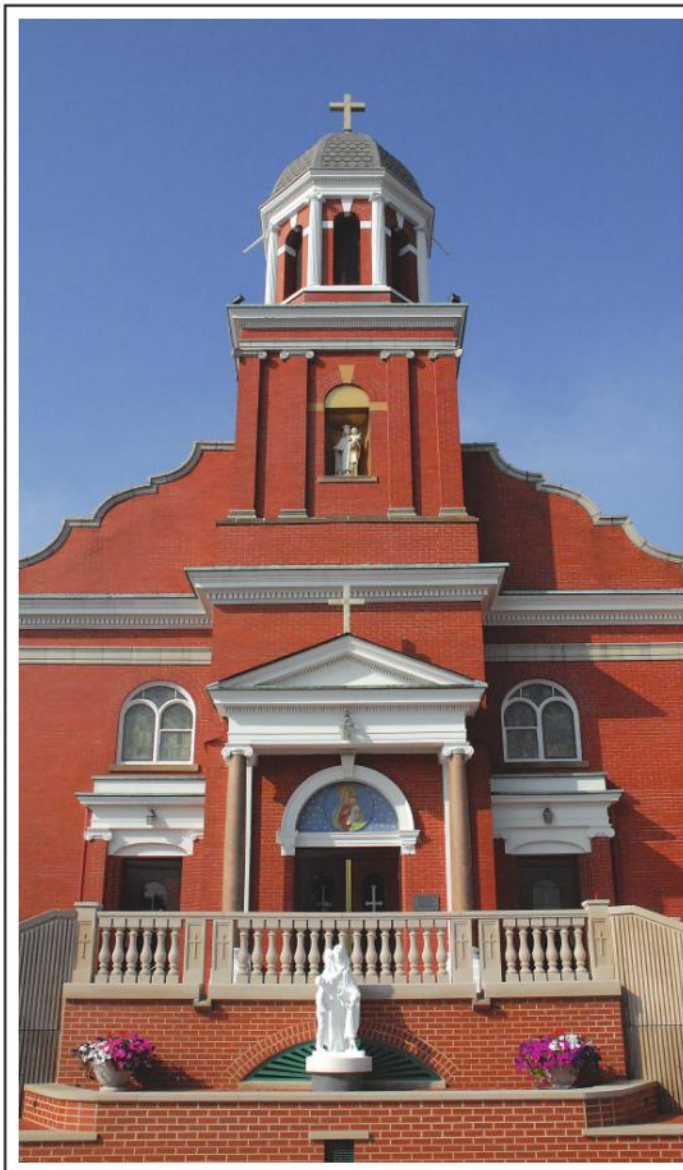

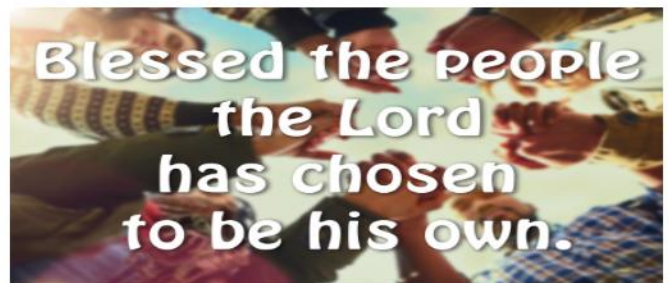

From Our Music Director

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica,

I want to take this opportunity to thank the congregation of our wonderful parish community for their participation at Mass each and every weekend. Hearing the voices of so many participants at Mass singing our hymns, psalms, and antiphons brings me great joy and adds so much to my ministry as your director of sacred music. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul states, "Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for the temple of God, which you are, is holy." As we hear these words, we remember that God dwells within each of us, and it is the human heart where music has its source. God is the giver of song and He is present when we sing His praises.

As Msgr. Cariglio announced last weekend, beginning Sunday September 1, our Sunday Mass schedule will change from three Masses to two: at 9AM and 11AM. Since we are reducing the number of Masses at the Basilica on Sundays to foster a greater group of attendants per Mass, I hope as you plan on adjusting your schedules, if you consider coming to the 11AM Mass this fall, that you would consider the music ministry of the Basilica as a possibility.

Of course, please don't hesitate to come up and see me after any Sunday Masses in the near future and express with me your interest. The regular choir is open to any person high school age or older. Thank you and may God bless you all as we look forward to a new chapter in our rich Basilica history. Therefore, beginning the weekend of September 1, 2019 there shall be celebrated the usual Saturday 5pm Mass. Every Sunday instead of three Masses celebrated, there shall be two Masses; 9am and 11 am.

I ask you to show yourselves as a genuine Faith Community and cooperate with this necessary change. As Rector of this Basilica dedicated to the Mother of God, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and as your Pastor let us continue to thrive in quality and grow in number. Let us open our doors in welcome, especially to those who are non-practicing Catholics.

For your information St. Anthony Church, Youngstown which is also part of the parish will be reducing Masses from two to one Mass every Sunday at 10 am.

May Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Saint Anthony of Padua bless and touch each of us with Grace and Love.
