From Our Music Director

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica, I want to take this opportunity to thank the congregation of our wonderful parish community for their participation at Mass each and every weekend. Hearing the voices of so many participants at Mass singing our hymns, psalms, and antiphons brings me great joy and adds so much to my ministry as your director of sacred music. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul states, "Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for the temple of God, which you are, is holy." As we hear these words, we remember that God dwells within each of us, and it is the human heart where music has its source. God is the giver of song and He is present when we sing His praises.

Thank you and may God bless you all as we look forward to a new chapter in our rich basilica history. May Saint Cecilia, the patroness of music, bless your hearts and voices as we sing to God in whatever capacity we are able to each week.

Carmel, and as your Pastor let us continue to thrive in quality and grow in number. Let us open our doors in welcome, especially to those who are non-practicing Catholics.

For your information St. Anthony Church, Youngstown which is also part of the parish will be reducing Masses from two to one Mass every Sunday at 10 am.

May Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Saint Anthony of Padua bless and touch each of us with Grace and Love.
