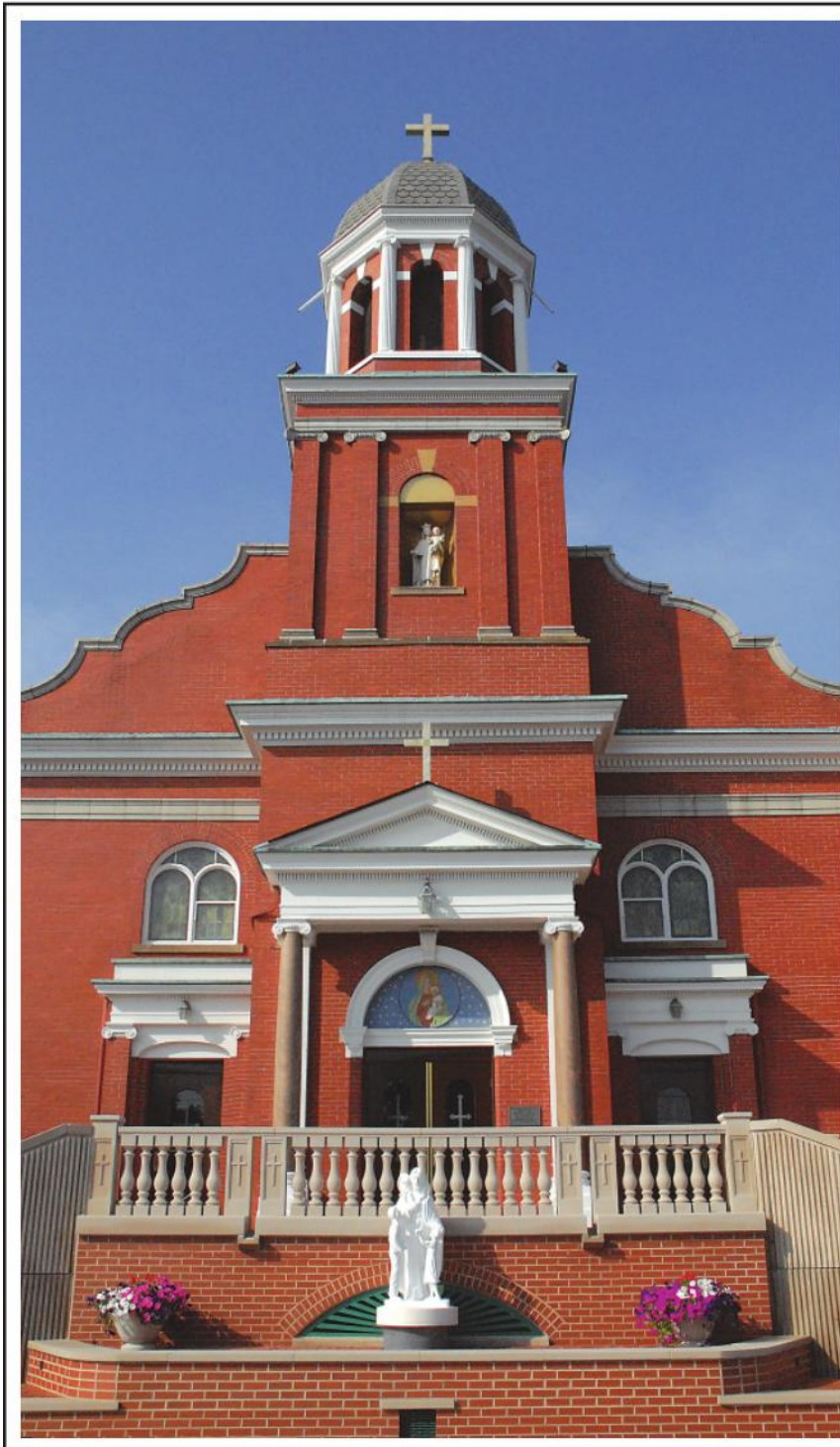

CRAIG'S CORNER

A Note
From Our Music Director

“Strive to enter through the narrow gate.”

Jesus tells us these words in the Gospel this weekend. We know the world is full of hardships and trials and that being Christian is not easy that sometimes makes it seem difficult to pursue in our faith. Jesus reminds us that the path to His kingdom is not easy: it is a narrow gate. The letter to the Hebrews in this weekend’s second reading recalls that these trials are our discipline. In another epistle, we hear that the summary of God’s law for entering this narrow gate is to love our neighbors as ourselves. This text is the inspiration for both Saturday and Sunday’s prelude as well as the theme of our opening hymn: Where Charity and Love Prevail.

This weekend we are challenged to “go out to all the world and tell the good news” as we sing in our psalm. We must do good to avoid the wailing and grinding of teeth which Jesus speaks of in the Gospel. We must love one another, and follow the way, truth, and life which is Jesus himself. While His way may be a challenge at times, let our music and Mass this weekend lift us up to living His law of love so that we go out into the world this and each week willing to suffer so that we can be among the few who will enter through the narrow gate. With the help of Christ and His Mother, Mary, we pray that we can be in His company forever.

In recent months Bishop Murry and his priests' council have expressed serious concern about the shortage of priests. They have studied the weekend Mass attendance and the size of each Church in our Diocese of Youngstown, seeking to reduce the number of Masses where warranted.

I have consulted the members of parish council, finance council, and our permanent deacon. I have listened most carefully.

Therefore, beginning the weekend of September 1, 2019 there shall be celebrated the usual Saturday 5pm Mass. Every Sunday instead of three Masses celebrated, there shall be two Masses; 9am and 11 am.

I ask you to show yourselves as a genuine Faith Community and cooperate with this necessary change. As Rector of this Basilica dedicated to the Mother of God, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and as your Pastor let us continue to thrive in quality and grow in number. Let us open our doors in welcome, especially to those who are non-practicing Catholics.

For your information St. Anthony Church, Youngstown which is also part of the parish will be reducing Masses from two to one Mass every Sunday at 10 am.

May Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Saint Anthony of Padua bless and touch each of us with Grace and Love.
