





TWENTY - SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



It doesn't take long to get the message in our head as we hear the scriptures presented this weekend. The theme of humility starts right in the first sentence of the first reading. Jesus reaffirms this thought in the Gospel as well. He was dining with the Pharisees, who often thought of themselves as high class because of their status in the Roman Empire. Jesus tells them, rather, when invited to a banquet to sit at the lowest place and a host can elevate your status. He reassures them that heaven is the true banquet and that those who exalt themselves will be humbled and those who humble themselves will be exalted. Serving one another instead of being served is the true path to Christ. We also sing of this in the psalm as we proclaim that God has made a home for the poor, not the rich.

The role of deacons in their ordained ministry is in service to the priests and God's people, the Church. As we all gather this weekend as a community for Mass, we also come to celebrate the ordination of Mark Izzo to the order of permanent deaconate for the Church in service to our parish at Our Lady of Mount Carmel - Saint Anthony and the Diocese of Youngstown. Mark, who faithfully served as director of music ministry at Mt. Carmel for 26 years prior to myself, chose The Servant Song as the offertory hymn to combine the role of deacon with the theme of service and humility that we hear from the readings as he celebrates Masses as our deacon this weekend. Mark wrote our communion hymn for the Basilica elevation Mass back in 2014. This hymn combines the Eucharistic banquet with our basilica coat of arms "lumen fidei" - light of faith. These hymns blend many the elements of our faith together into one text. The Servant Song summarizes our duty as Christians with the example of our Gospel message this weekend, to be servants to one another and to Christ – in humility. The hymn Alleluia! Sing to Jesus is another hymn which blends the aspects of our faith and the Eucharistic feast we celebrate together. Jesus, though he may not be here on earth in physical body form, is here with us through the Eucharistic banquet. As we thrive to be nourished this weekend, we are reminded of what it truly means to serve one another and to do our service with humility.

I personally want to congratulate Mark on his ordination. Mark was so gracious to me while I was studying organ at YSU's Dana School of Music, to assist him in his music ministry at the basilica. He showed me a true example of humility in the way he carried out his ministry directing the choir, preparing the Masses, and serving on the organ bench. May God bless him in his new ministry serving us and Monsignor Cariglio and other priests in their ministry of service to the community.


