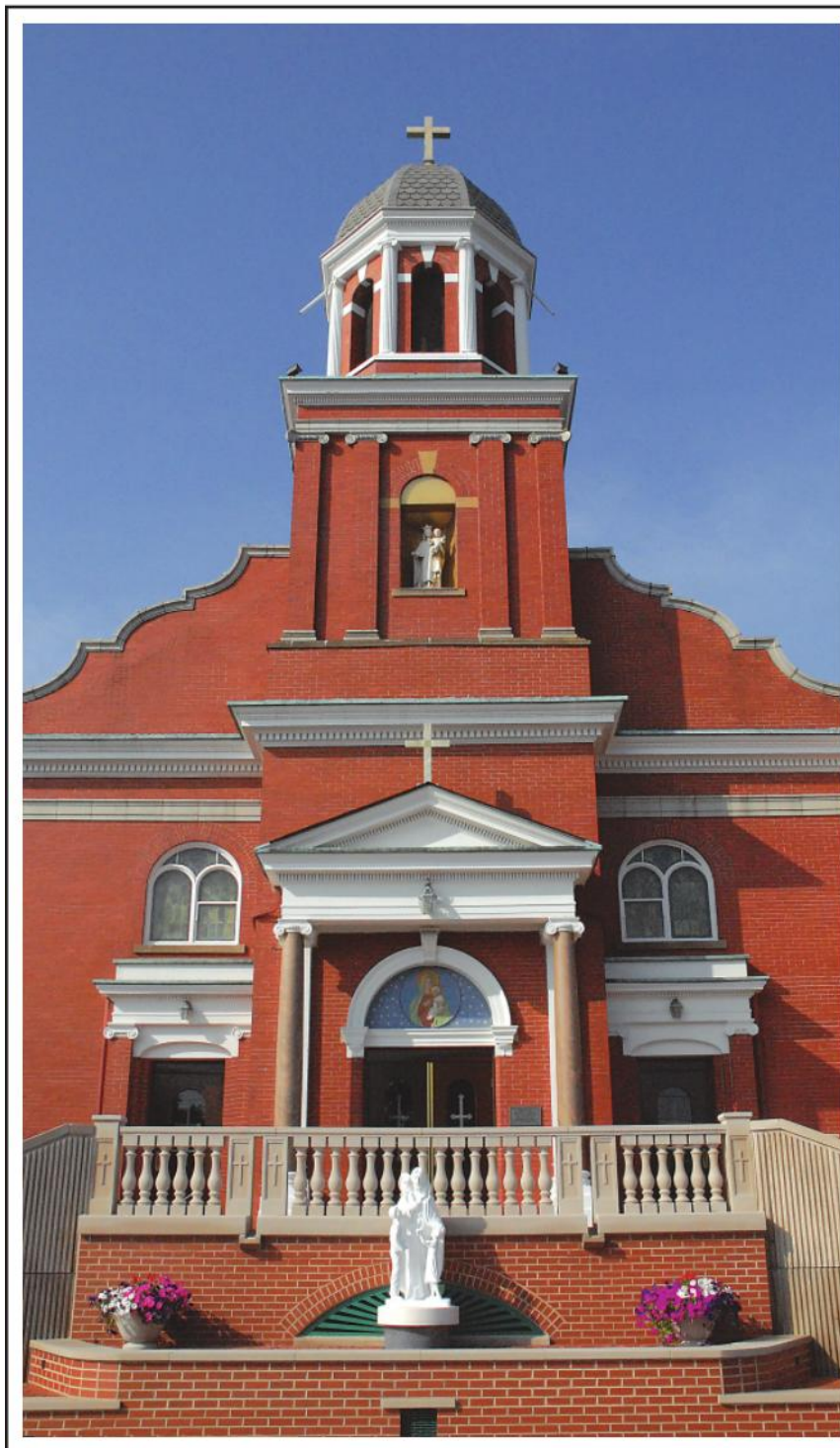

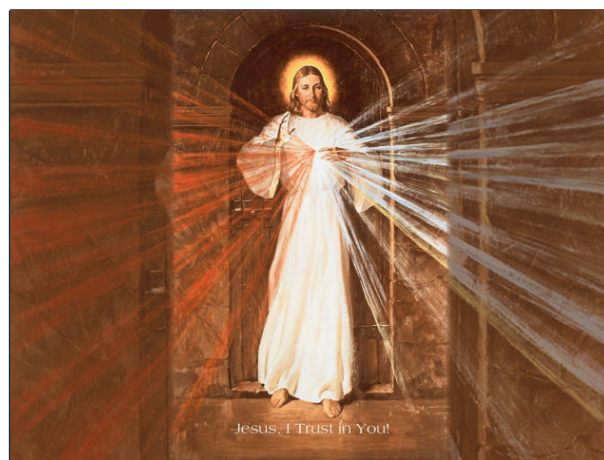

The **Image of the Divine Mercy** or more correctly the **Image of Merciful Jesus** is a depiction of Jesus based on the devotion initiated by Saint Faustina Kowalska.

"I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish," Jesus told Faustina, according to her diary, which has been studied and authenticated by the Church over several decades. "I also promise victory over enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I myself will defend it as My own glory." (*Diary* 48)

Jesus is shown in most versions as raising his right hand in blessing, and pointing with his left hand on the Sacred Heart from which flow forth two rays: one red and one pale. The depiction contains the message **Jesus I trust in you**. The rays streaming out have symbolic meaning: red for the blood of Jesus (which is the Life of Souls), and pale for the water (which justifies souls) (*Diary* 299). The whole image is a symbol of charity, forgiveness and love of God, referred to as the "Fountain of Mercy". According to the diary of Saint Faustina, the image is based on

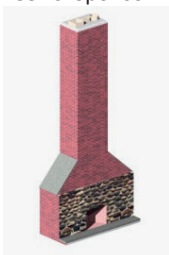

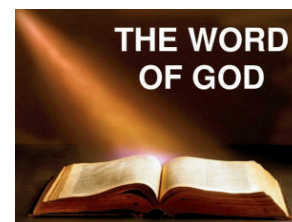

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who in his great mercy gave us a new birth to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.
