

In John 14:15-21, Jesus tells us that the Holy Spirit is our "Advocate". Some scholars translate the word to "Coun-selor". In the original Greek, it means "called alongside". It's closely related to the verb "parakaleo" ("to call" or "sum-mon") from which we get "Paraclete" as a name for the Holy Spirit. It referred to a le-gal assistant, a courtroom ad-vocate.

Jesus is telling us that the Holy Spirit is our legal assis-tant when we're falsely accused, misjudged, or wrongly condemned.



Notice that Jesus refers to our Advocate as the "Spirit of Truth". No matter what other people think about us, no matter what wrong things they say about us, no matter what opinions they have of us, God always knows the truth. And the truth that sets us free from their bad atti-tudes is this: It's only God's opinion that really matters. And his opinion of us is better than we think it is!

We judge ourselves more harshly than we should, and this is why we worry so much about how others are judging us. If we honestly examine our consciences, seek reconciliation with God for our sins during the Pen-ance Rite at Mass or in the Sacrament of Confession, and strive to improve, then Jesus says to us what he said to other sinners: "I do not condemn you; go and sin no more."

Don't you sometimes wish Jesus would come physically to your rescue when you're misjudged? He said that he will not leave us orphaned – his Holy Spirit will always be with us when we need to be defended, telling us the truth about our goodness.


Even when we sin, the Spirit of Truth defends us to our heavenly Judge: "Look, this precious child really does want to be holy." To us, the Spirit says, "Let me teach you how to grow in holiness and avoid this sin." And to others, the Spirit says: "If you love me, love this good friend of mine."

Reflect & Discuss:

1. How have you been unjustly ac-cused and unfairly judged? Imag-ine what the Holy Spirit is saying to the Father about that. And to those who condemned you. And what is he saying to you about you?

2. Describe a time when God de-fended you. How did the Advo-cate manifest his help?

3. Who learned more from it: you or your accusers?
