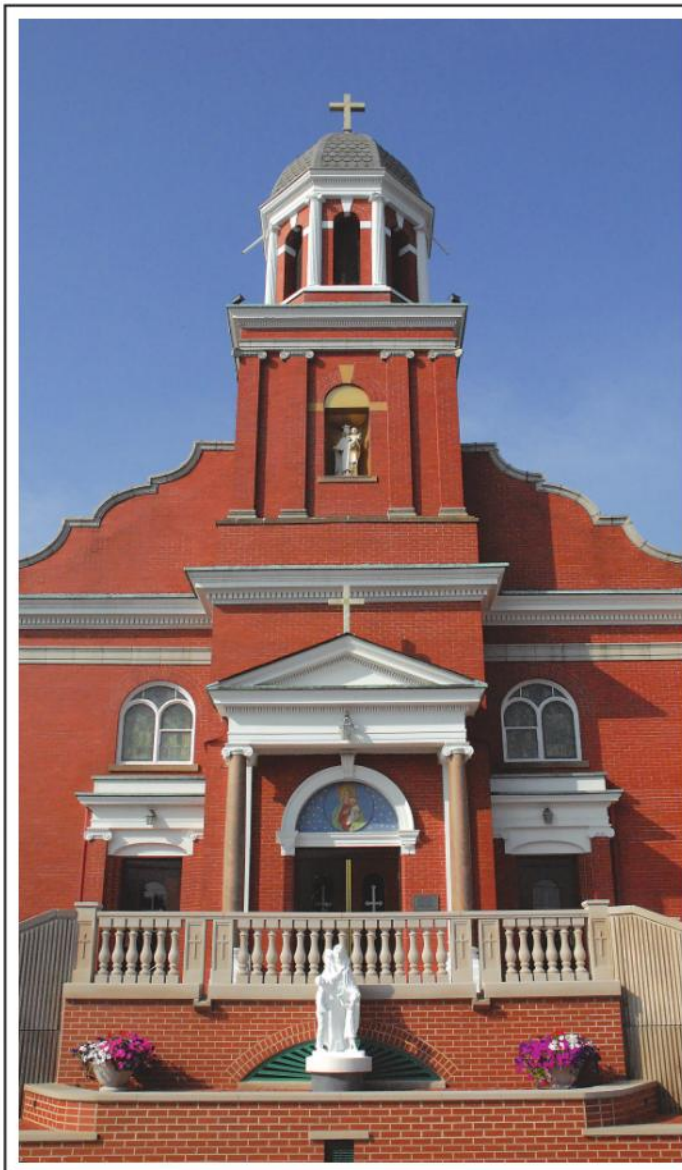

**CRAIG'S CORNER**  
**A note from our music director**

The common phrase “when one door closes, another door opens,” often comes to mind at the end of the Easter season. While yes, we *technically* ended one Liturgical season which we celebrate the fundamental basis of our faith. As I mentioned last week, Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, this is where **our** part truly begins. We, now energized by the Spirit of God dwelling in us, need to go out and preach by Word and example the Good News now that the celebration of our redemption through Christ is complete. This weekend’s solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity is a perfect way to begin this stretch of our Liturgical Year of Ordinary Time. Everything we have celebrated in our faith (even if via live streamed Masses the past few months), now points to us but with the help of our triune God. This weekend is an excellent summary of our faith. God the Father: who is, was, and is to come. God the Son: who came to the world to teach, to preach, heal, suffer and save. And God the Spirit, the breath of God Himself empowering us to carry on the mission of Christ through the Church.

How do we do this? Saint Paul answers this perfectly in today’s second reading: “Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the holy ones greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.” These are in part, the same words that the priest says to us at the beginning of each Mass. At the Mass we are one, united in the trinity in one faith – putting any differences aside for the common faith in God the Father, Son and Spirit. That is what we are as Church, but that needs to extend into our everyday lives.

As I mentioned last week, we will be singing a lot of antiphons and refrains in the coming weeks. Our entrance antiphon this weekend proclaims the Trinity: “Blest be God the Father, and the only begotten Son of God and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown to us his merciful love.” As the Trinity on a theological level is such a complex mystery, one thing is simple: the merciful love of God is showered down to all of us, so we must pass that mercy and love onto each other. This echoes the Gospel today where John reminds us that God didn’t send us the Son for condemnation but rather to have eternal life. That’s how you sum up the Trinity. That God the creator loved us all so much that the Son came to bring us eternal life and sent us the Spirit to live within us to be the Church on earth. Now that the Easter season of celebrating the act of our redemption has closed, our door of proclaiming the Good News is now opened to go forth with the help of Mary our Mother, and sing the praises of the Triune God while living in peace with one another.
