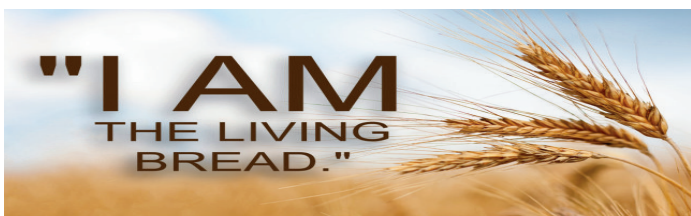

A note from our music director

I wanted to use my space in the bulletin this weekend to share a reflection on our dear diocesan Bishop, who of course as we all know passed away last week.

I was blessed to be one of the delegates from Ursuline High School back in 2007 when Bishop Murry was installed as the fifth bishop of the Diocese of Youngstown, and I got a chance to introduce myself to him after that Mass where I talked to him about my love of the Catholic faith and my interest in liturgical music. As I graduated Ursuline and began my time as an organ student at YSU's Dana School of Music, I joined the Saint Columba Cathedral choir where we sang many of Bishop's events. Of course, he also came to Mount Carmel on many occasions where we would get a chance to catch up, even to the point where he learned of my interest in trains and he would always inquire about local railroad news from me when we would chat. His first question was always be, "How's the family?" and the second, "How's the trains?"

It was his outgoing personality and loving nature which made him more than a bishop. His humble personality made joking and smiling with him very easy. We would go to lunch on occasions where he would express his thankfulness for my ministry in music between our beloved basilica and cathedral parish families.

As we sang and Monsignor Cariglio mentioned last weekend (and as you may have heard me mention on WKBN), Bishop Murry's favorite hymn when he would come to the basilica was "As I Kneel Before You." He always reminded me when he was here how much he loved the hymn. While this hymn was not included in his final revision of funeral wishes for the Mass, I was able to play it during the public calling hours at the cathedral on Thursday. I was humbled and honored to be able to do that in his memory and to represent the basilica. I was also humbled to be chosen as one of the few choir members invited to the private Mass for the repose of Bishop's soul on Friday.

The last Mass we celebrated at the cathedral with Bishop was a 4PM Sunday Mass not too long ago. After Mass was over, I was chit-chatting in the choir loft when I heard Bishop's voice from the sanctuary call "CRAIG! ARE YOU UP THERE?!" I am SO glad he called me down to say hello as that ended up being the last time I would see him. Pictured here are he and I from Pentecost 2019 at the cathedral.

St. Anthony Heals the Sick



This Sunday we celebrate the Sacrament of the Eucharist and the reason why we believe it is truly and physically the presence of Jesus.

In the first reading, we're reminded that God always provides the food and drink we need for survival in the desert days of life's hardships.

What he did for the Israelites, he does for us whenever we experience hot trials and dry faith. He provides what we need by giving us the True Presence of Christ, who comes to us in the bread of Mass (the Eucharist), and in the presence of his Holy Spirit dwelling within us (Baptism and Confirmation), and in the priest whose ordination makes Jesus present to us in Confession.

The Gospel passage tells us that the Eucharistic food and drink are truly Jesus himself, not a mere symbol of his love. Oh-my oh-my, how we need this food and drink to survive the serpents and scorpions and the parched and water-

less ground of our desert experiences! Jesus literally fills us and quenches our thirsts. As we consume him, he consumes us. As we draw him into us, he draws us into himself. In this unity, we walk through our trials with all that we need for success.

The second reading tells us that the Eucharist increases our unity with Christ's body on earth, the church community through which he provides the various resources that we need. In this unity (when it's activated



as it should be) no one lacks anything good because all necessary goods are shared. And ultimately in this unity, as Jesus said in the Gospel, we're assured of eternal life in heaven, where all needs are met perfectly and completely.

Reflect & Discuss:


1. What are the "serpents and scorpions" in your life right now?
2. In what ways do you feel parched, thirsty to the point of desperation?
3. During Mass, imagine that you're walking through a desert to receive from Jesus what you need. How does it feel to approach Jesus this way?
4. How has the Eucharist helped you through a difficult time? Why did it make a difference?
5. Some people kiss the Host before placing it in their mouths; what do you do that helps you become more aware of the presence of Christ in the Eucharist for all your needs?
