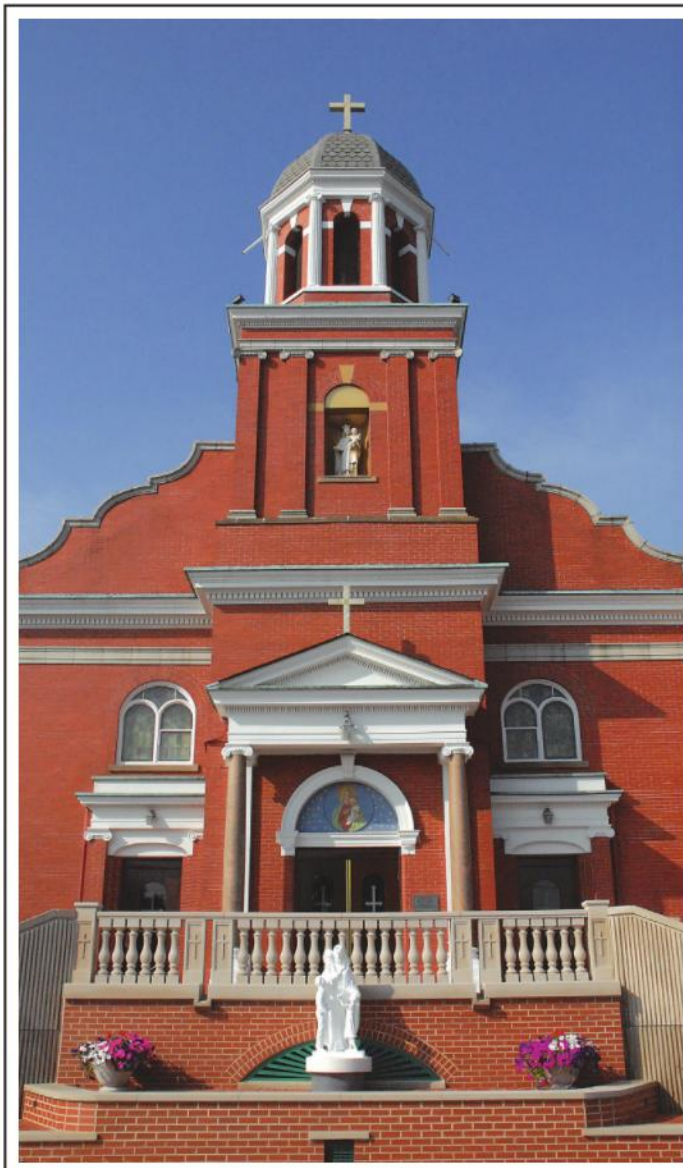

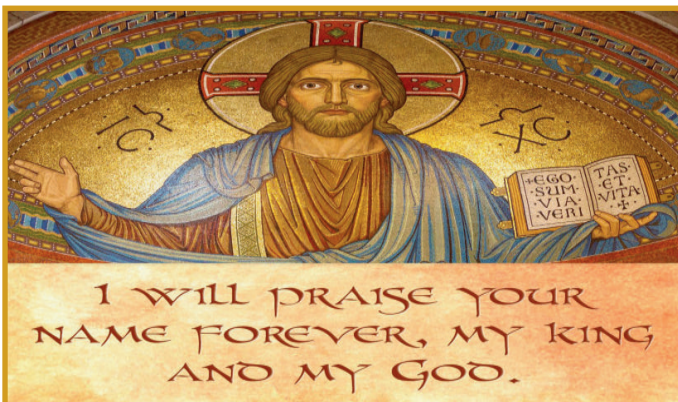

CRAIG'S CORNER

A note from our music director

A little over a month ago we celebrated the Solemnity of Pentecost. The solemnity ended the Easter season and is referred to as the birthday of the Church. That day, the Spirit of the Lord came down upon the apostles who were locked in the upper room. Once they received the Spirit, they were empowered to bring the Gospel message to the ends of the earth.

This weekend in the second reading in Saint Paul's letter to the Romans, he reminds us that if we belong to Christ we have His Spirit within us as well. Jesus reminds us, as he did last weekend, that to belong to Him is to be in service to the little ones. To be a servant of Christ, we cannot associate with the wise and learned (those who think they already know everything and can't be taught) but rather the innocent and those who are willing to be open to the Spirit. He then continues by showing us His calming and comforting side reminding us that we can place our cares upon His shoulder.

This text from the Gospel is directly quoted in our Communion antiphon this weekend, "Come to Me." For the opening and offertory of this weekend's Masses, we focus again on the Spirit. The text of our entrance hymn is taken from the sequence of Pentecost Sunday where we pray that the Holy Spirit come upon us, the Church, the poor, and lighten our hearts with love and to send down the gifts of the Holy Spirit to empower us to proclaim and live out the Gospel.

These texts should resonate with us each day of our lives, not only on Pentecost. The Spirit of God is the fire inside of each one of us which must be kept burning to be a servant people. As we pray our Masses this weekend and listen to the hymns of the Spirit and the communion antiphon of Christ's consoling nature and easy yolk, may we remember that if we want to attain our everlasting home, we need to become like the little ones, anxious to grow and hear the word of Christ with His Spirit dwelling within each one of us.
