





## CRAIG'S CORNER A note from our music director

Last weekend I wrote about how the Spirit guides us as Christians to live out our call of discipleship. That was echoed in the second reading while connecting to the Gospel where Jesus made sure we came directly to him with our cares and, as Monsignor described in his homily, our different types of fatigue. In his homily he also mentioned the four arms of the Mayo Clinic. As Divine Intervention would have it, one of the verses of our opening hymn last weekend, "Come, Holy Spirit on us Shine" also talked about these arms: "Come, light be with us every day: in prayer, at rest, at work, at play. Without your help we go astray." I promise you, we didn't plan it that way!

As we come to the altar this weekend, we take these messages as now we hear the Gospel of the parable of the kingdom of God being compared to seed being cultivated in the proper environment. This environment was what Monsignor talked about last week, where we combine all aspects of life and bring them straight to God. If we don't take our faith seriously, if we don't cultivate it and just go through the motions, we will fail and wither away. We need to cultivate it with proper treatment - prayer, works of mercy, celebration of the Sacraments, and all of the other nutrients we need to get closer to God. As we continue the novena to our Blessed Mother under the title of our patroness, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, we remember that she also is a way to bring us closer to Her Son.

Jesus' parables in Matthew's Gospel which we will dive into this summer, all share a common theme: the Kingdom of God. Our music will speak in different ways relating to God's kingdom as well. This weekend, we sing the common refrain to "Blest are They." This hymn's setting of course is the text of the Beatitudes which we are so well familiar with. This text surrounds us with images of God's kingdom and how He chose not those with fame and fortune, but rather those who were poor in spirit, the lowly ones, those who hunger and thirst: these are those who will have their fill in Christ's kingdom. As we focus on Jesus' parables and learn from Him the ways to the kingdom – this weekend hearing how we need to cultivate our faith seeds to be strong through proper nurturing, let us ask our Blessed Mother during these novena days to help us become closer to her Son and the Spirit which reigns in each one of us so that we can one day reign in His kingdom.

# God News INSPIRATION FOR DAILY LIFE

Sunday's readings are about sowing seeds. The portant thing to remember about seed sowing is that the effort is worthless if the changed by being cast to the ground. Each seed must give up its former self, dying in the dirt while new life stirs within it. Only then can it send out a tender, first root, which will multi-

ply and grow stronger and deeper to support upward growth. Even so, it has to be properly nourished to survive.

If all this takes place, the end result is a plant that looks nothing like the seed, which as it grows develops the evermore important mission of benefitting the wider world of Nature beyond itself.

As we listen to Jesus explain the parable, we say yes, we want to be seeds that become fruitful lives. But desiring it does not automatically trans-

form us. What is it that makes the soil of our lives rich and growth-producing?

The reading from Isaiah tells us that it is God himself who is the rich soil – God and his Word. Saint Paul reminds us in the second reading that suffering is part of creation (seeds must fall in the dirt and die in order to produce a fruitful life). Redemption grows from suffering and death.



We will never feel truly fulfilled until we've surrendered to the soil and have allowed God to nourish our growth.

#### Reflect & Discuss:

- What tender, new roots do you have that are sprouting from times of suffering and loss?
- 2. What blessings are springing up from them?
- 3. What ministry (what benefit to others) could be a fruitful gift of these blessings?
- Share with your family or faith sharing group what it means to give up your former self to allow new life to stir and grow.
- What is the will of God (what does the Word say) regarding the end result? Give examples from your life or from the lives of others.
