Saint Mary Magdalene JULY 22

Mary Magdalene sometimes called Mary of Magdala was a Jewish woman who, according to the four canonical gospels, traveled with Jesus as one of his followers and was a witness to his crucifixion and its aftermath. As Jesus traveled from city to city proclaiming and bringing good news of the kingdom of God, according to the Gospel of Luke his twelve were with Him along with Mary Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out. Mary occupied a similar position among Jesus's female followers as Simon Peter did among the male apostles. Mary Magdalene was one of the first to discover the empty tomb. She went inside and saw a young man dressed in white, who told them that Jesus had risen from the dead, then the risen Jesus himself appeared and told her to go tell the apostles. "I have seen the Lord", which Paul uses in 1 Cor.9:11 to claim apostolic status.
