## TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

All three Synoptic Gospels tell the story of the Transfiguration (Matthew 17: 1-8, Mark 9: 2-9, Luke 9: 28-36). With remarkable agreement, all three place the event shortly after Peter's confession of faith that Jesus is the Messiah and Jesus' first prediction of his passion and death. Peter's eagerness to erect tents or booths on the spot suggests it occurred during the Jewish wedding, fall Feast of Booths.

Tradition names Mt. Tabor as the site of the revelation. A church first raised there in the fourth century was dedicated on August 6. A feast in honor of the Transfiguration was celebrated in the Easter Church from about that time. Western observance began in some localities about the eighth century.

On July 22, 1456 Crusaders defeated the Turks at Belgrade. News of the victory reached Rome on August 6 and Pope Callistus III placed the feast on the Roman calendar the following year.
