ST. ANTHONY PIZZA UPDATE

We have received numerous inquiries on the status of St. Anthony Pizza. We appreciate your interest and want nothing more than to get back in the kitchen making pizzas but only when we feel its safe for our workers. Traditionally after summer we have started up the first Friday after Labor day. This year it is our goal to sale pizzas on Saturdays only if the Covid numbers do not get any worse. If we should start back at that time it will be with some changes until this virus is under control.

1. All orders must be pre-ordered on Wednesdays or Thursdays by call 330-360-7663.
2. There will be a limited number of pizzas made and orders will stop when we reach that number. There will not be any phone calls taken the day of sales.
3. Anyone picking up their order must have a mask on or you will not get your pizza. No more than two people at a time will be allowed to enter the building, as one customer leaves another one can enter.
4. There will be a slight price increase, the regular pizza will now be \$8 and toppings will be \$1 each. Please bear with us as the health of our workers is very important to us. Thank you for your interest and we will keep you posted as we have more information.
