**TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
TODAY'S FOCUS: JESUS CHRIST IS LORD!**

The phrase "Jesus Christ is Lord!" comes off the tongue easily enough, but have we stopped to examine the many implications inside it, the truly radical nature of that claim?

Paul knows that God's word has not failed, so Israel's refusal to accept Jesus as Messiah must be part of God's intention from the beginning. It has allowed for the extension of salvation to the Gentiles. This plan for the salvation of the world reveals God's wisdom, which remains inscrutable and unsearchable, even as the outlines come slowly into view. This is cause for wonder and reasons to give glory to God, whose ways may not be known, but can be trusted.

**THE PASSION OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST
AUGUST 29TH**



Shortly after he baptized Jesus on the banks of Jordan, John the Baptist had denounced Herod, the tetrarch of Galilee, to his face.

For thirty years the dissolute rule had indulged himself and his every whim, while holding court in his palace. Herod had divorced his own wife and married Herodias, the wife of his elder brother Philip.

No one dared to confront him about this scandalous action except John, known as the Baptist, and believed by many to be a prophet.

For proclaiming the truth, John was imprisoned. Herod dared not take any further action against him. As was common back then, he was superstitious, and he knew him to be a "righteous man." But, during Herod's birthday for which an elaborate banquet and lavish entertainment was to be laid out. His marriage to his sister in law and John's arrest had not been well received by his people although none voiced their opinions but John.

Herodias's daughter was the only performance and it so pleased Herod that he promised her whatever she would ask for. Thus was the elaborate trap set by her mother. Salome requested the head of John the Baptist.

A guard was sent to behead John in prison. Thus, the "voice crying in the wilderness" was silenced. The head was placed on a platter and presented it to Salome, who gave it to her mother. From that moment onwards, an eclipse takes place. St. John Baptist mission was fulfilled.

O God, who willed that Saint John the Baptist should go ahead of your Son both in birth and in his death. Grant that as he died a Martyr for truth and justice, we, too, may fight hard for the Confession of what you teach. Through our Lord, Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.
