TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS: MOVING ON, EVEN IN PAIN

We all think we understand how things should proceed, have an instinct about how life should go. There are times, however, when the unexpected calls on us to release our grasping and our certainty.

Children grow up. Spouses die. Friends move. Grandmas go to eternity. We may be tempted to hold our loved ones back, but we cannot save them. Are we be prudently protective or self-servingly possessive? To release others is something we have to do, even though it hurt. The Lord guards them for eternity; no one will snatch them away. SAINT TERESA OF CALCUTTA

The remarkable woman who would be known as Mother Theresa began life named Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu. Born on August 26, 1910 in Skopje, she was the youngest child born to Nikola and Drane Bojaxhiu, Receiving her First Communion at the age of five, she was confirmed in November 1916. Her father died while she was only eight years old leaving her family in financial straits.

Gonxha's religious formation was assisted by the vibrant Jesuit parish of the Sacred Heart in which she was very involved as a youth. She moved to pursue missionary work at the age of 18 to join the Sisters of Loreto, in Ireland. She received the name Sister Mary Teresa after St. Therese of Lisieux. In December of 1929, she deported for her first trip to India, arriving in Calcutta. After making her First Profession of Vows in May 1931, Sister Teresa was assigned to the Loreto Entally community in Calcutta where she taught at St. Mary's School for girls.

Sister Teresa made her Final Profession of Vows, on May 24, 1937, becoming as she said, the "spouse of Jesus" for "all eternity". From that time on she was called Mother Teresa.

It was on September 10, 1946 during a train ride from Calcutta to Darjeeling for her annual retreat, Mother Teresa received her "inspiration, her call within a call>" On that day she would never explain, Jesus thirst for love and for souls took hold of her heart and the desire to satiate His thirst became the driving force of her life. After a short course with the Medical Mission Sisters in Patna, Mother Teresa received permission to begin. She entered through the gates of her beloved Loreto convent to enter the world of the poor. She was beatified by Pope John Paul on October 19, 2003, and canonized on September 4, 2016 by Pope Francis.
