TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME TODAY'S FOCUS: GO AND TELL-CAREFULLY

Resolving conflicts is always difficult; in the context of the church it can be downright tricky. Disciples are called to continual discernment through the Spirit, for the well-being of the community.

In prayer and discernment with others we ask: What does God want me to do? What is my motive for opening this conversation? Will speaking up worsen the situation? Like Ezekiel, if God is unmistakably calling you to "be a sentinel," then proceed carefully, but in courage do proceed. Jesus himself suggests that we have a back-up plan ready.

Lord Jesus, you found yourself in many sticky situations. You know how tangled human life can be. As we gather together in you name, be here in our midst and give us clarity.
