**TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
TODAY'S FOCUS: CAN YOU BE COACHED?**

God doesn't seek out the perfect, but looks for those who are willing, who are humble, who will try, and-when and if they fail-will try again to do God's will.

The parable of the farmer who had two sons. He asked the first to go out and plow the fields, he replied no but later felt guilty and went out and plowed the field. The second son told his father yes and did nothing. This parable presents a clear analogy: only who actually do the will of God, even if they refuse at first, will enter the kingdom. The chief priests and the elders, who thought they were following the will of God, were given the opportunity to reassess that belief when John came preaching repentance. They refused to listen to him. Those who thought they had no need to repent were mistaken.

**SAINTS MICHAEL, GABRIEL, &
RAPHAEL, ARCHANGELS**



The three Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael are the only angels named in Sacred Scripture and all three have important roles in the history of salvation.

MICHAEL, is the "Prince of the Heavenly Host, "the leader of all the angels. His name is Hebrew for "Who is like God?" and was the battle cry of whose forces cast down Lucifer and the evil spirits into Hell, is invoked for protection against Satan and all evil.

Christian tradition recognizes four offices of Saint Michael: 1 to fight against Satan 2 to recue the souls of the faithful from the power of the enemy, especially at the hour of death 3 to be the champion of God's people 4 to call away from earth and bring men's soul to judgment.

GABRIEL whose name means "God's strength," is mentioned four times in the Bible. Most significant are Gabriel's two mentions in the New Testament: to announce the birth of John the Baptist to his father Zacharias, and at the Incarnation of the word in the womb of Mary. He appeared to St. Joseph and to the shepherds and also that it was he who "strengthened" Jesus during his agony in the garden of Gethsemane.

RAPHAEL, whose name means "God has healed" because of his healing of Tobias' blindness in the Book of Tobit. Tobit is the only book in which he is mentioned. His office is generally accepted by tradition to that of healing and acts of mercy.

Raphael is also identified with the angel in John 5: 1-4 who descended upon the pond and bestowed healing powers upon it so that the first to enter it after it moved would be healed of whatever infirmity he was suffering.
